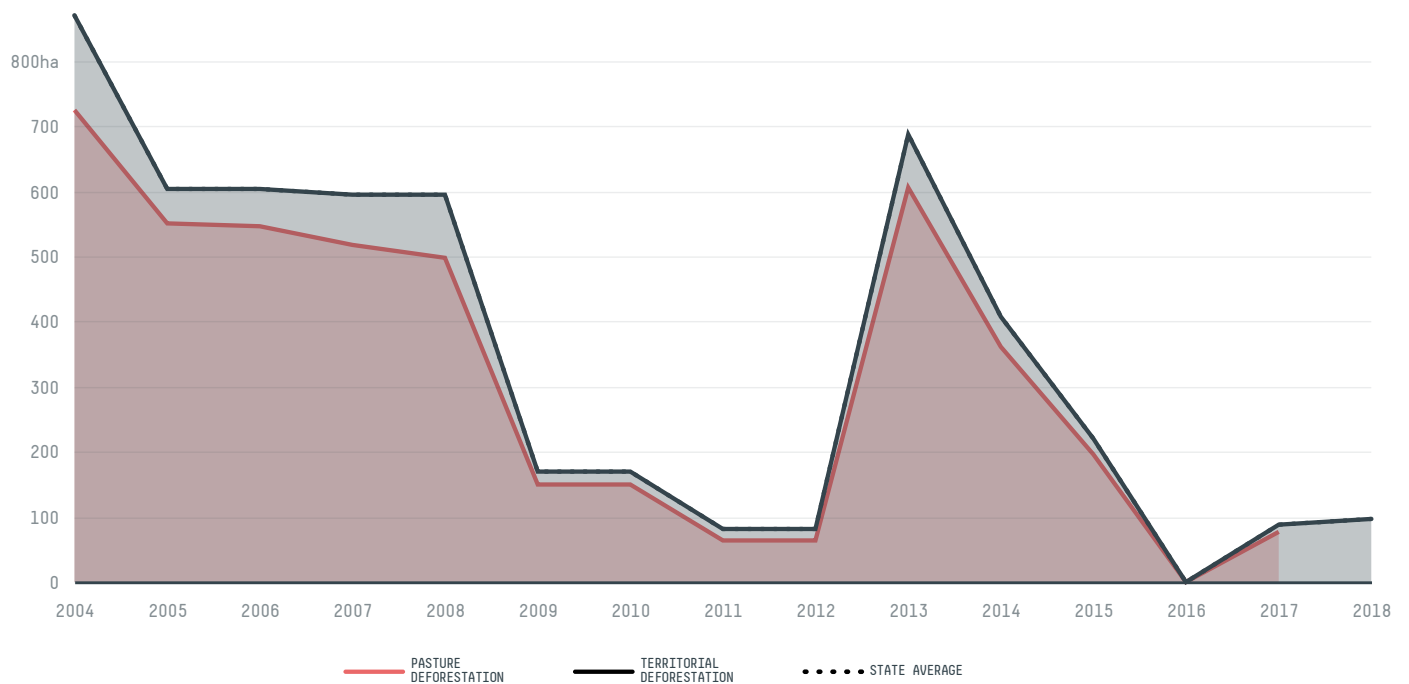
The largest exporter of beef in Morro Da Garca was Plena Alimentos, which accounted for 56.3% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

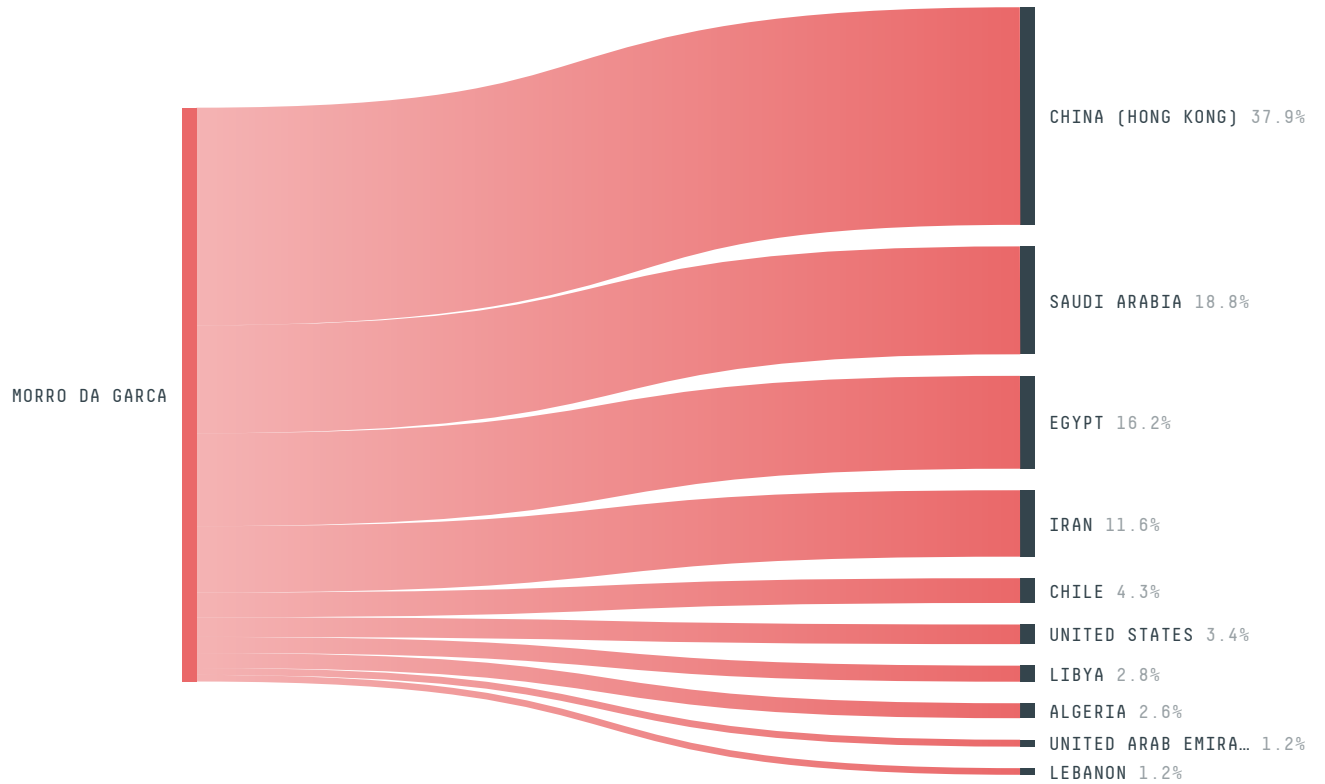

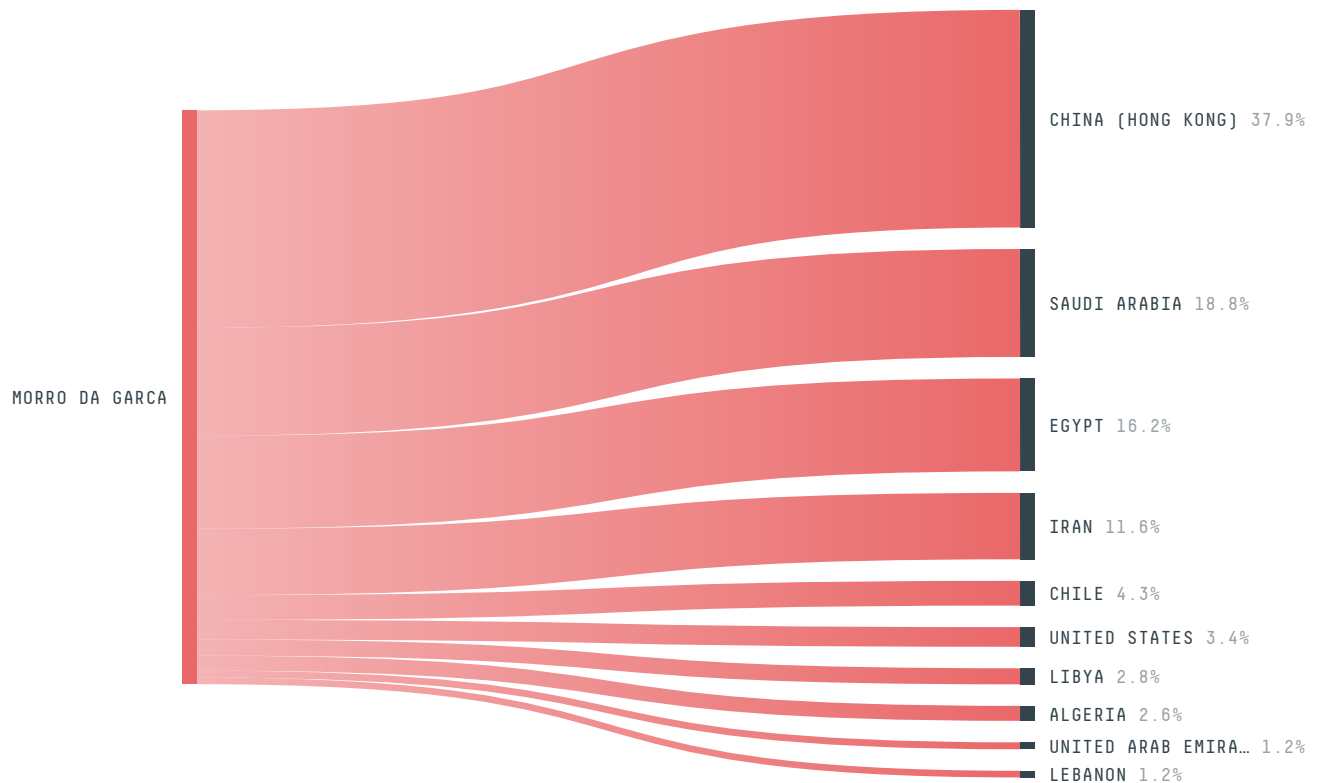
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MORRO DA GARÇA
