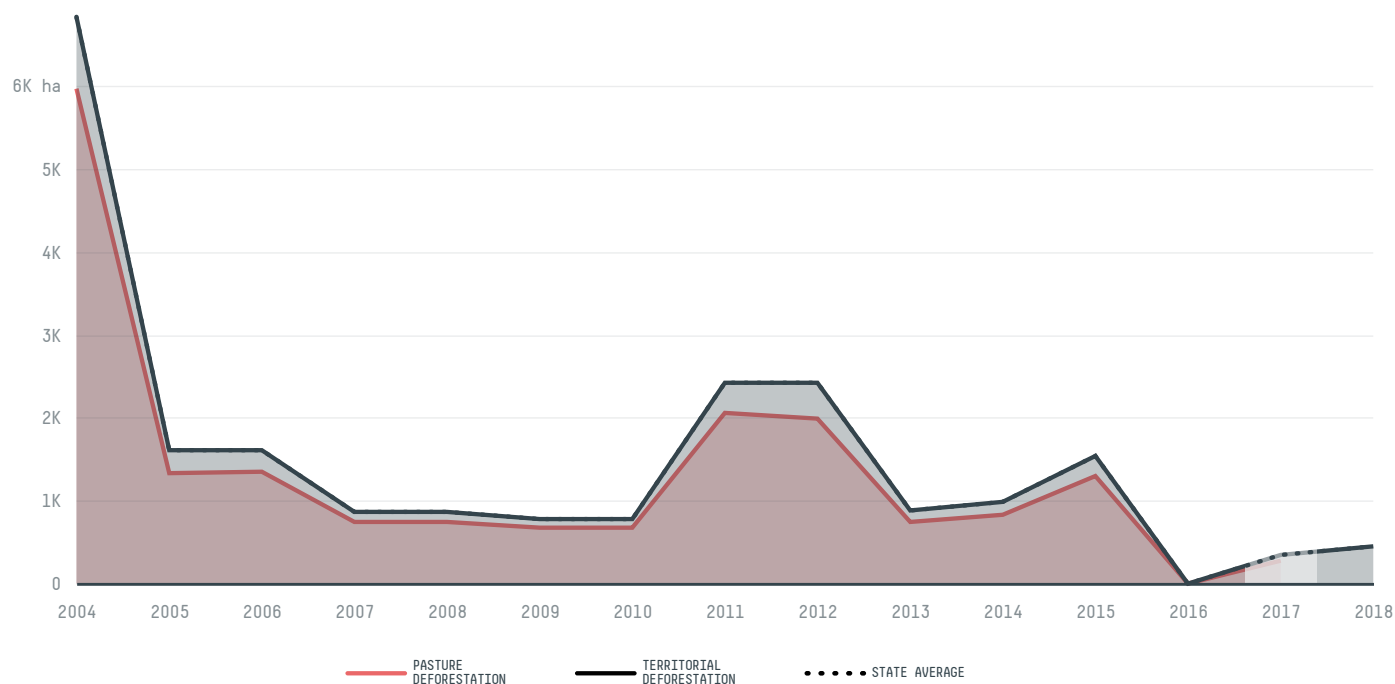

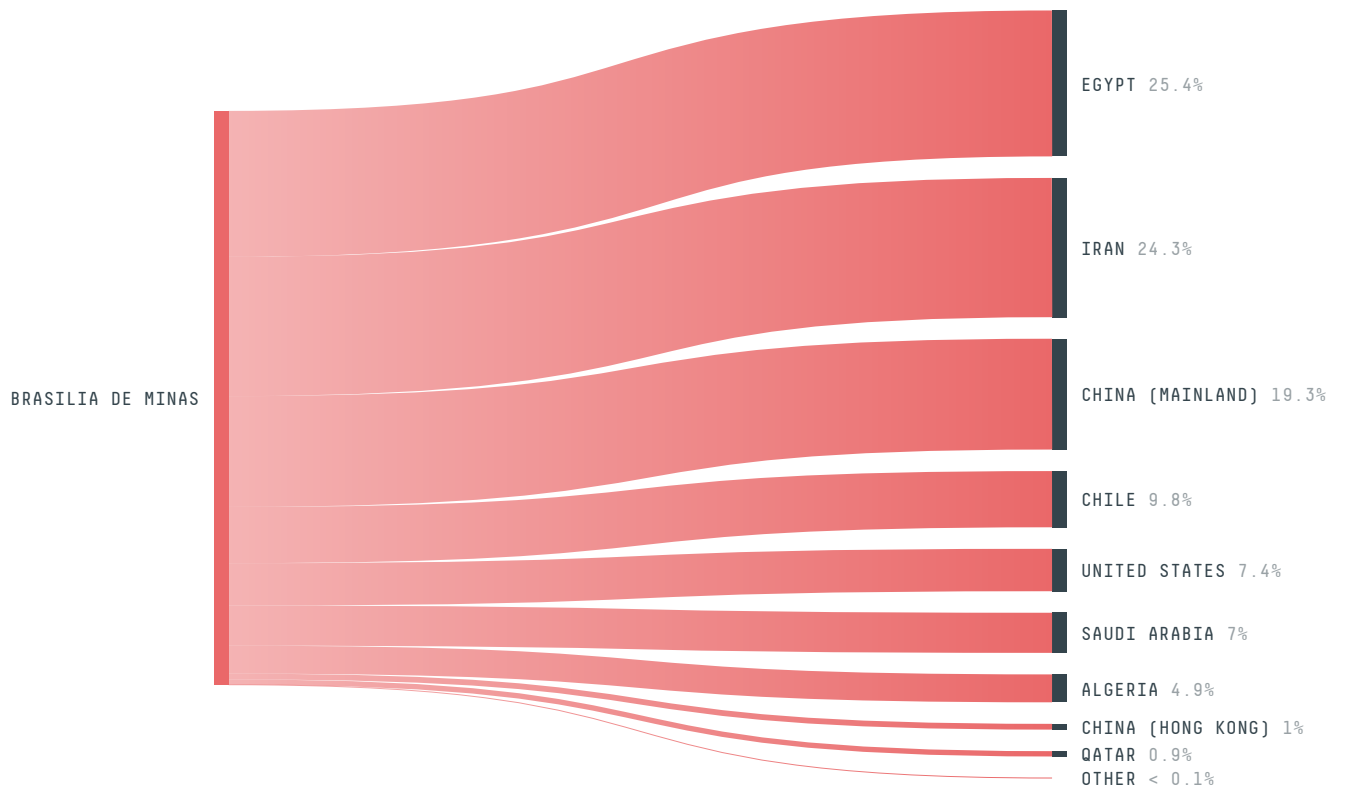
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BRASILIA DE MINAS
