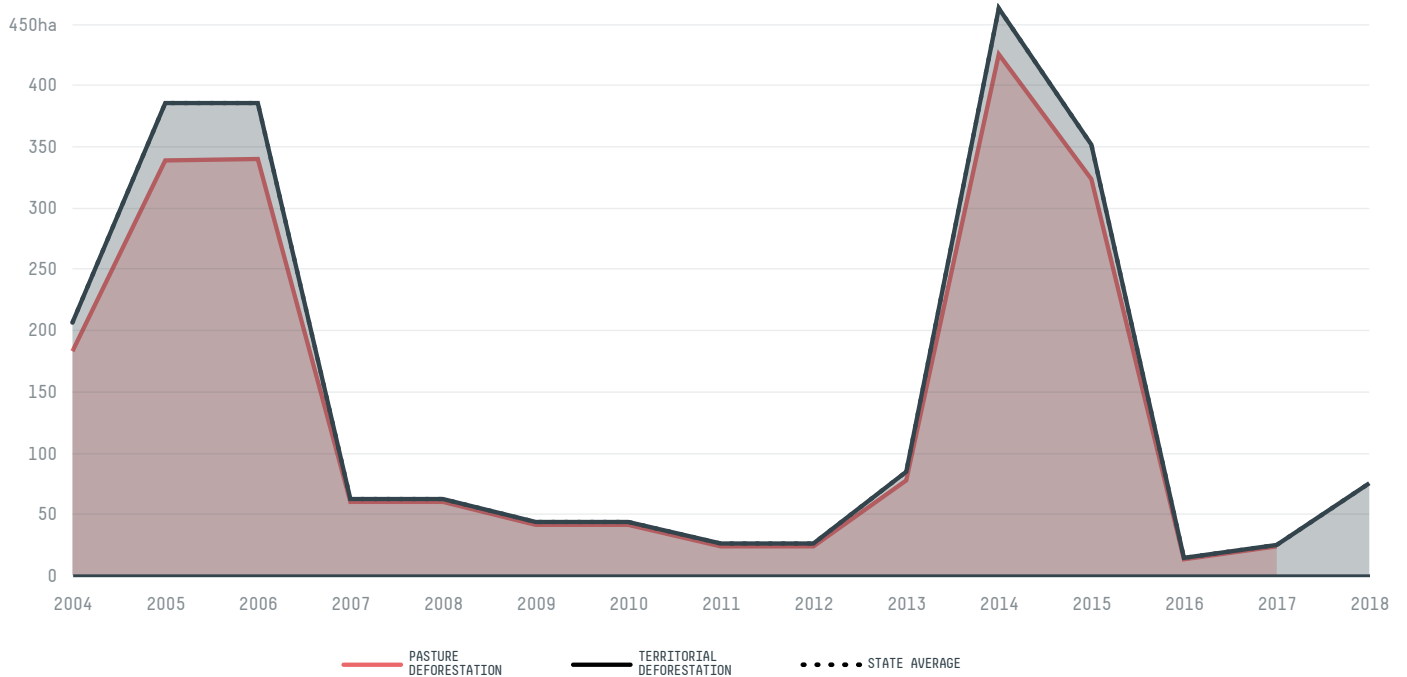

The largest exporter of beef in Espinosa was Minerva, which accounted for 69.2% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.

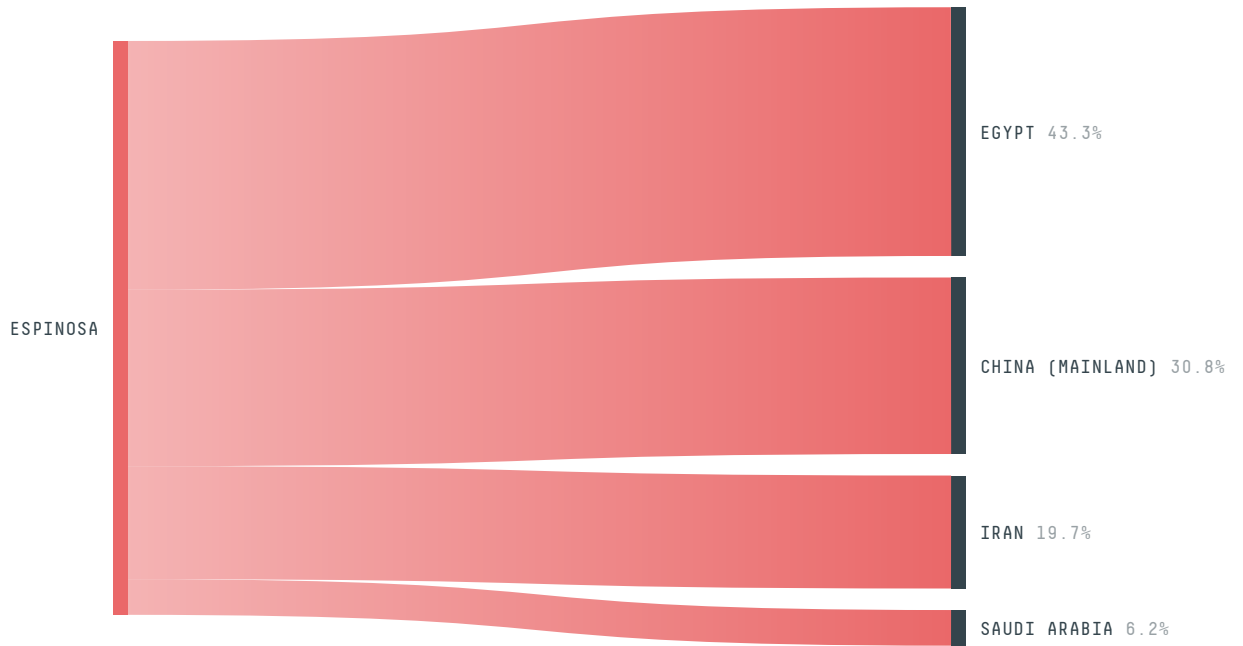
