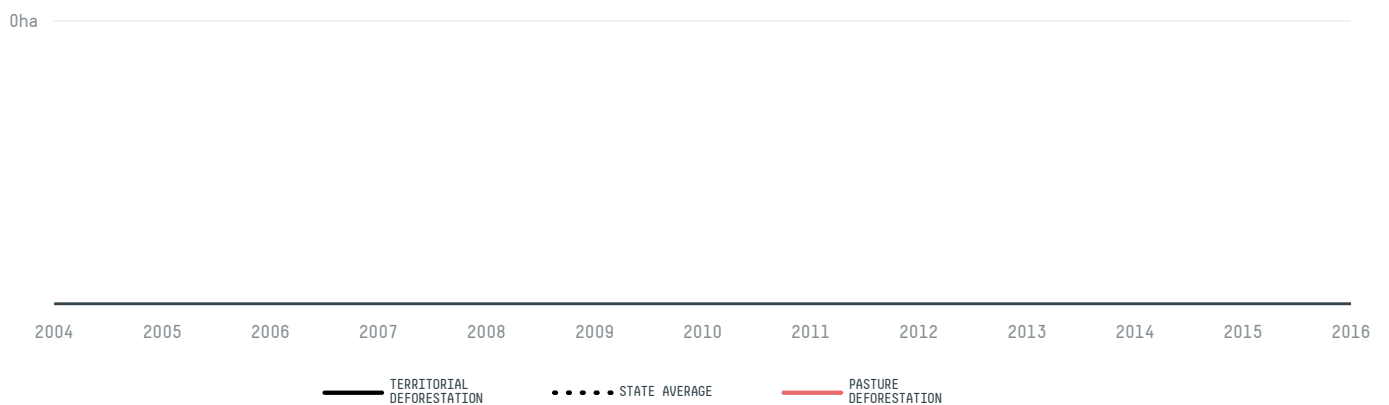

The largest exporter of beef in Salmourao was Marfrig Global Foods, which accounted for 36.2% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

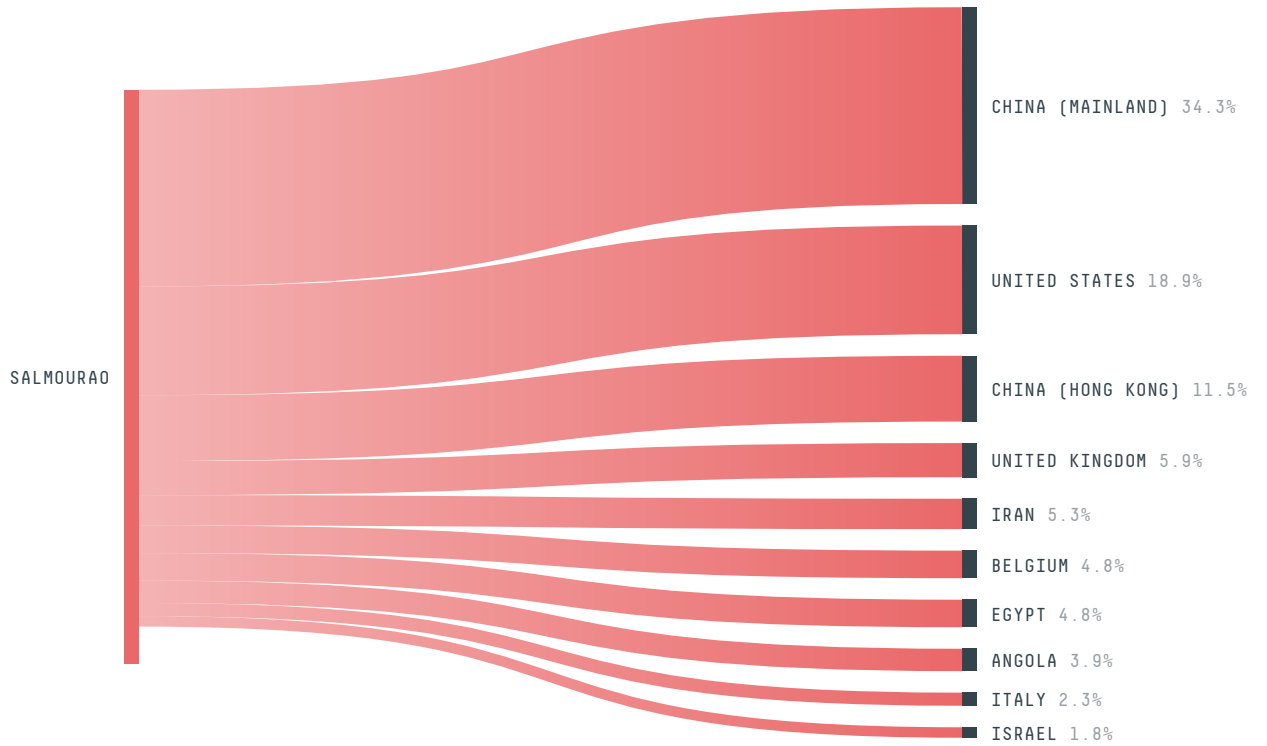

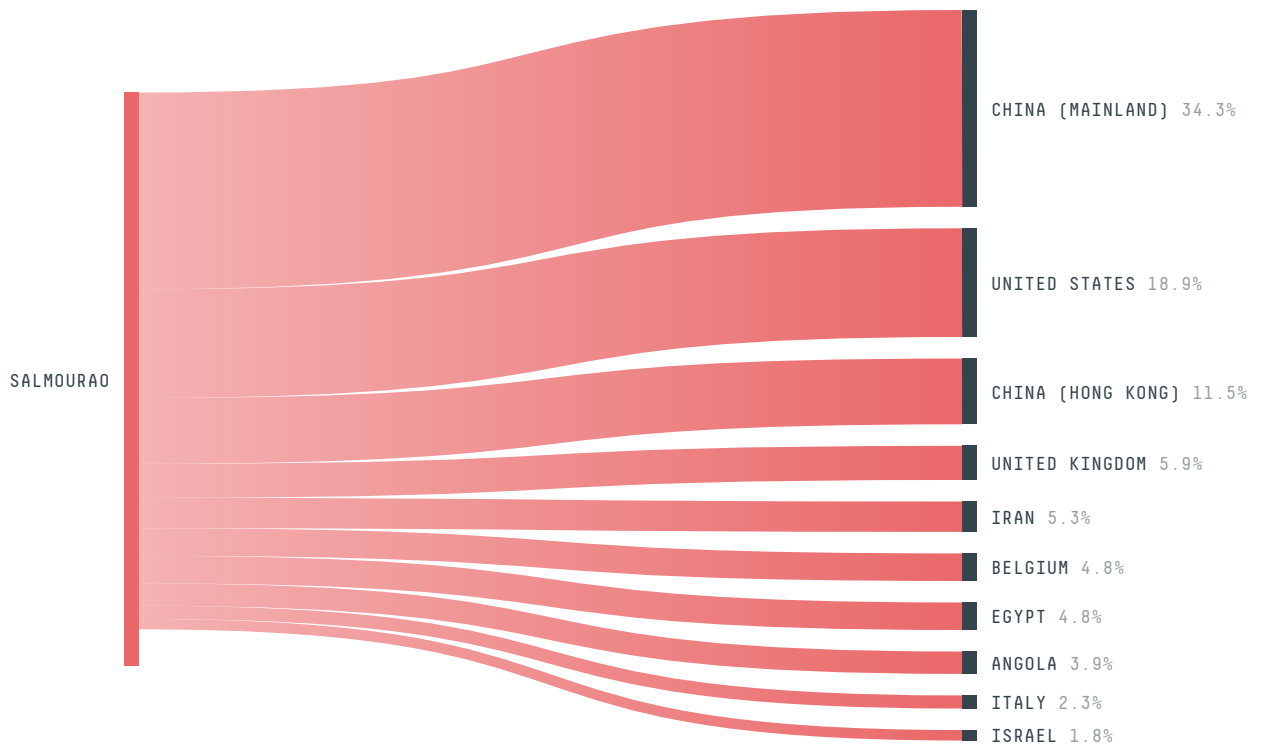
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SALMOURAO
