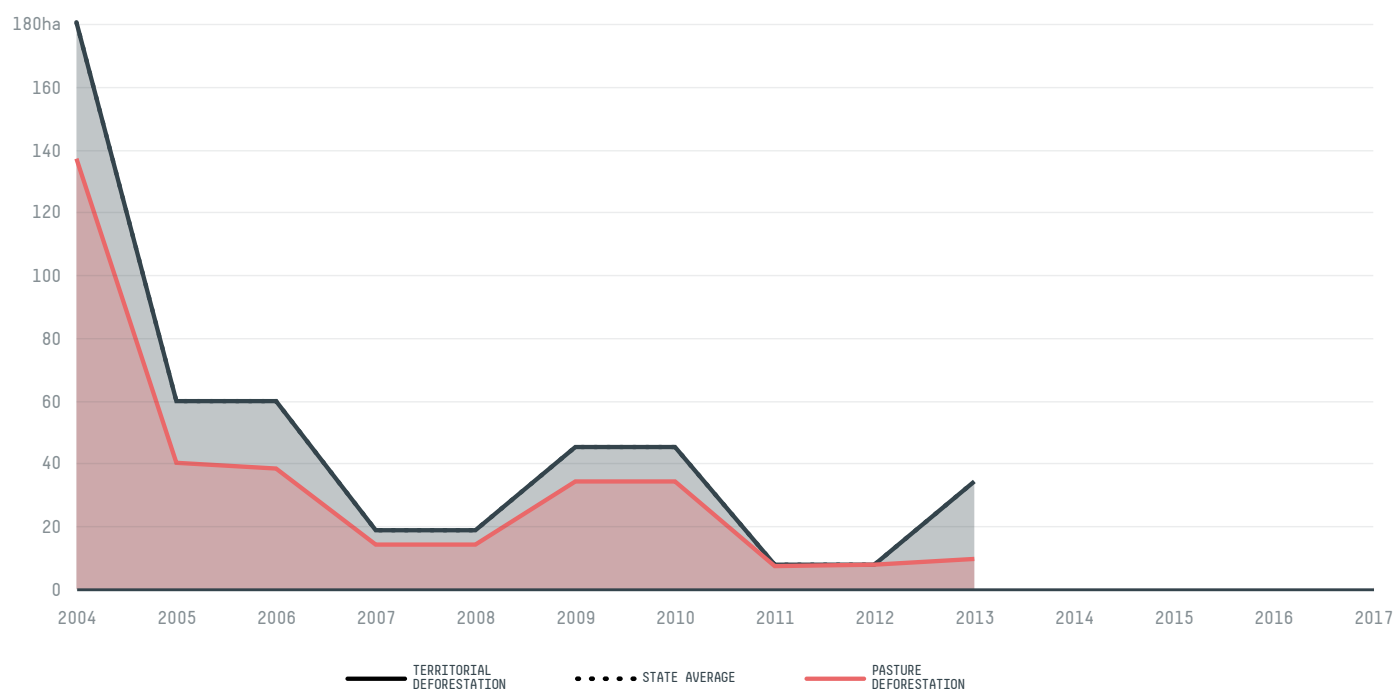

The largest exporter of beef in Nova Granada was Marfrig Global Foods, which accounted for 34.3% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

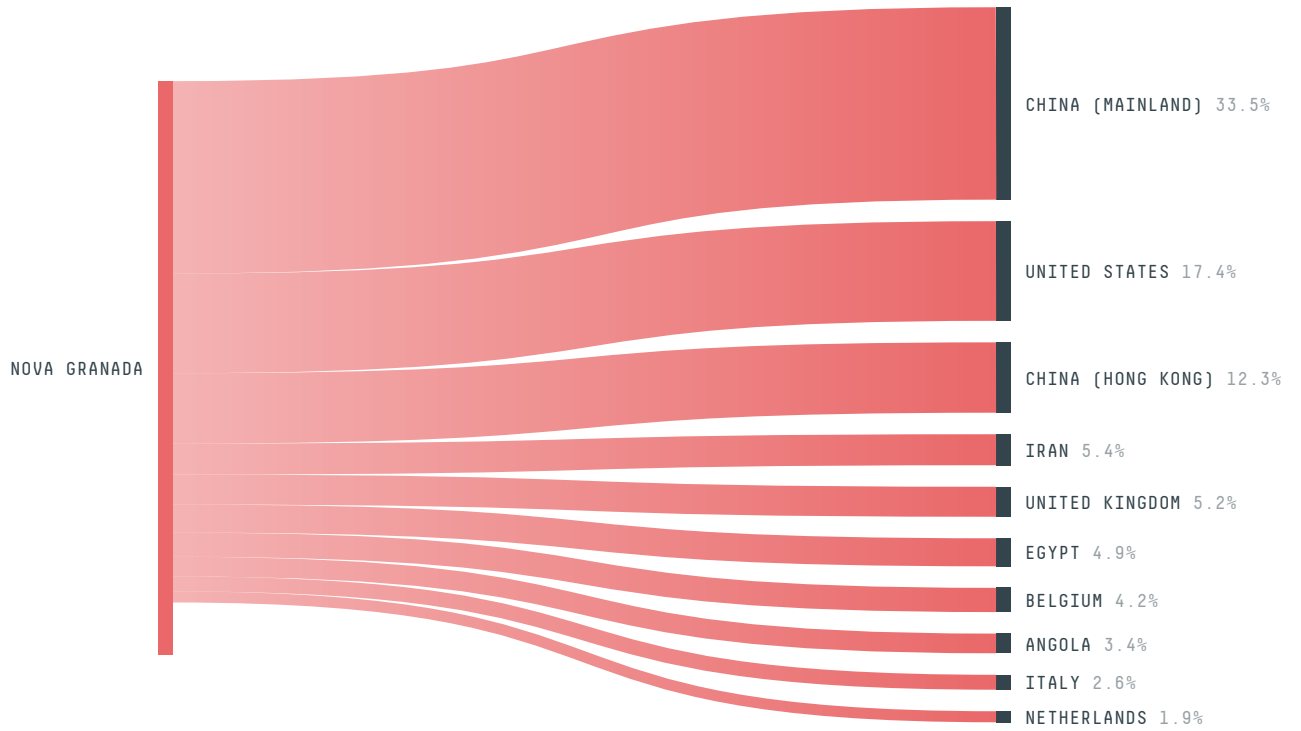

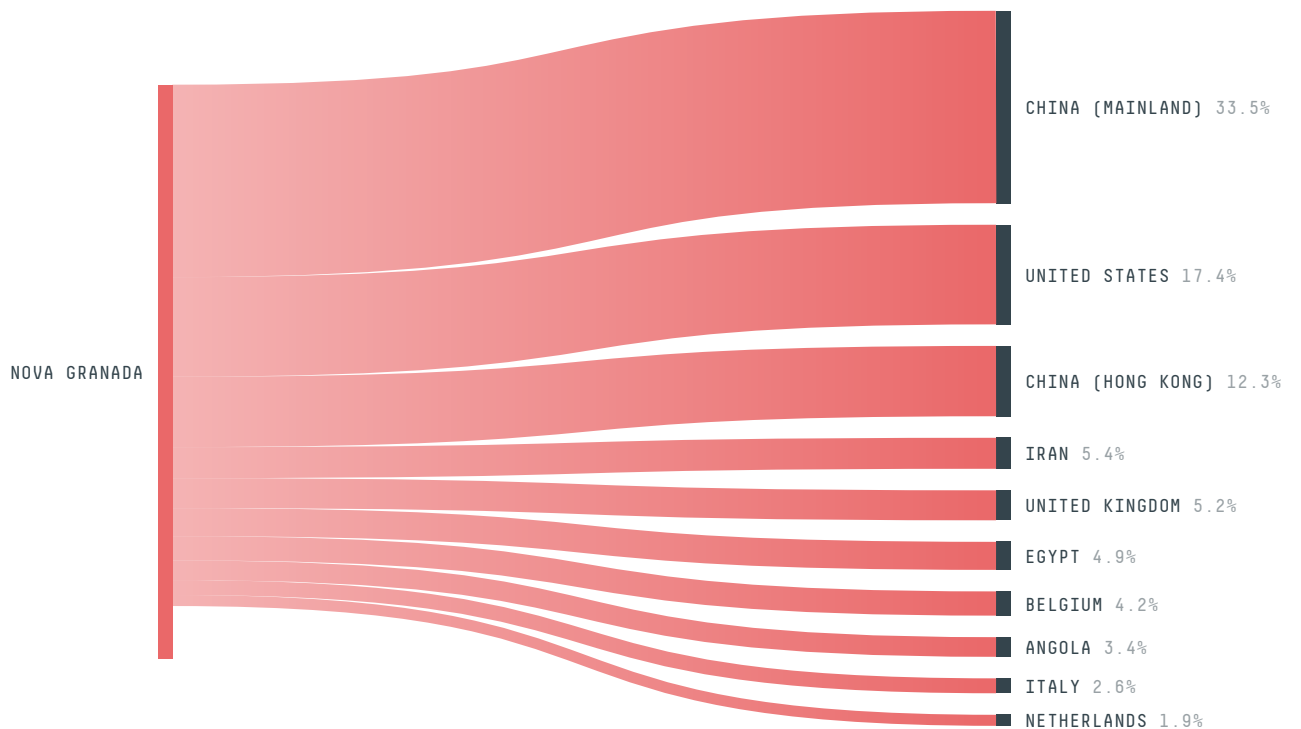
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NOVA GRANADA
