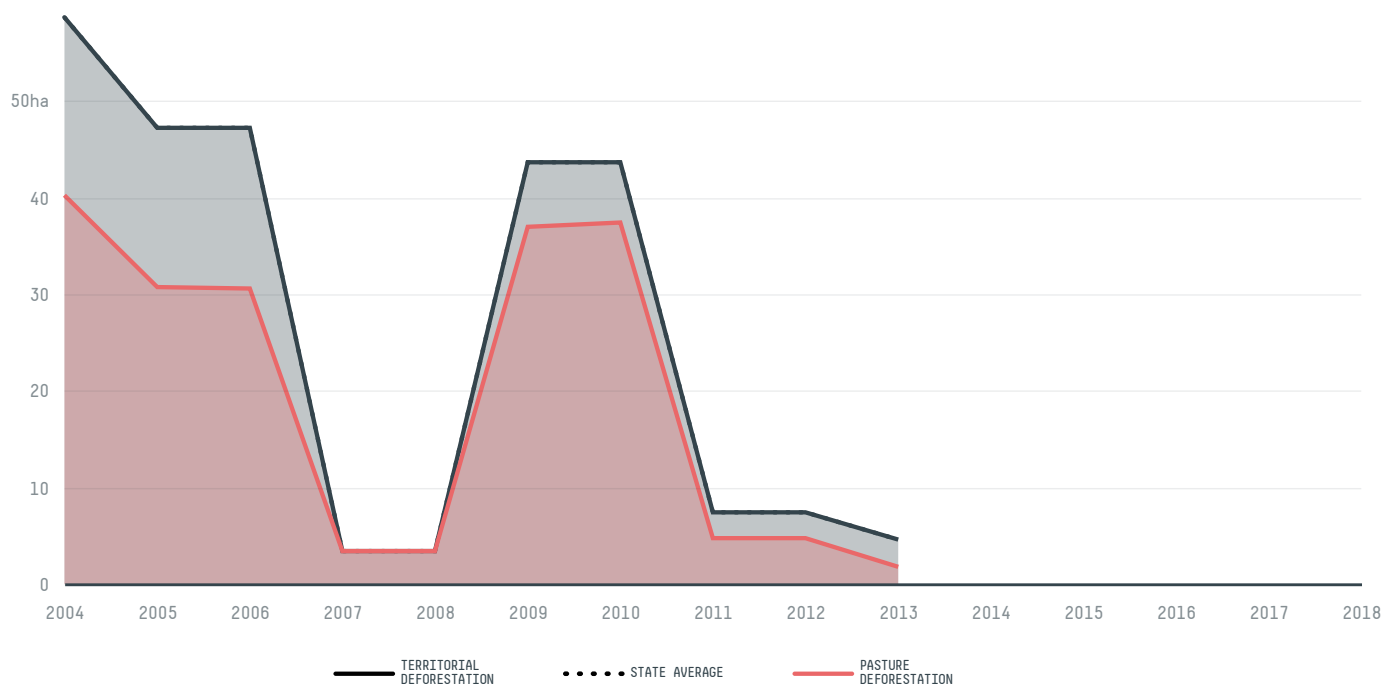

The largest exporter of beef in Itobi was Marfrig Global Foods, which accounted for 32.6% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

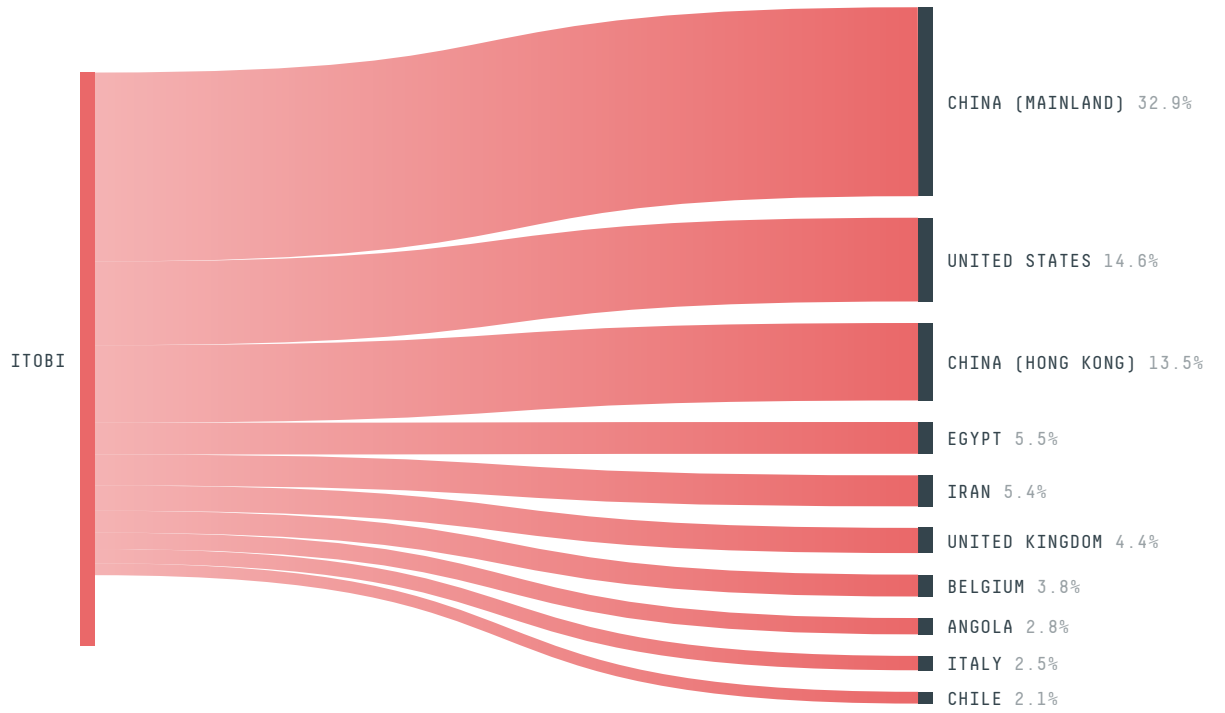

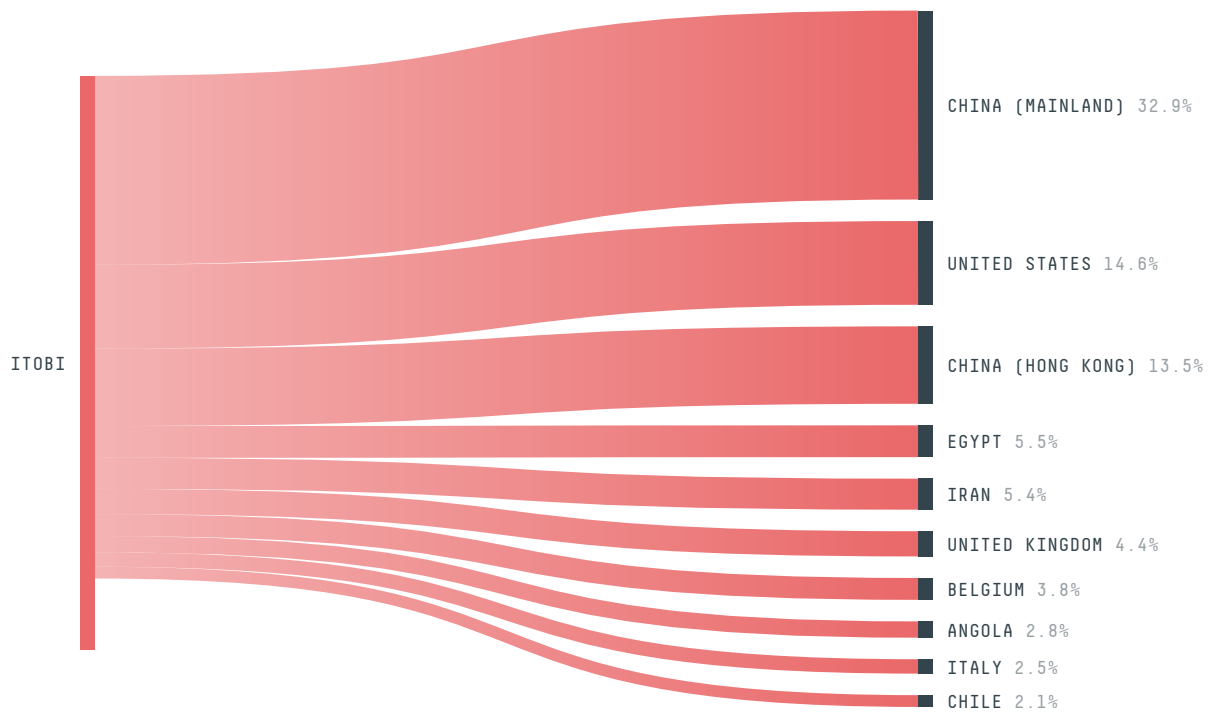
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ITOBI
