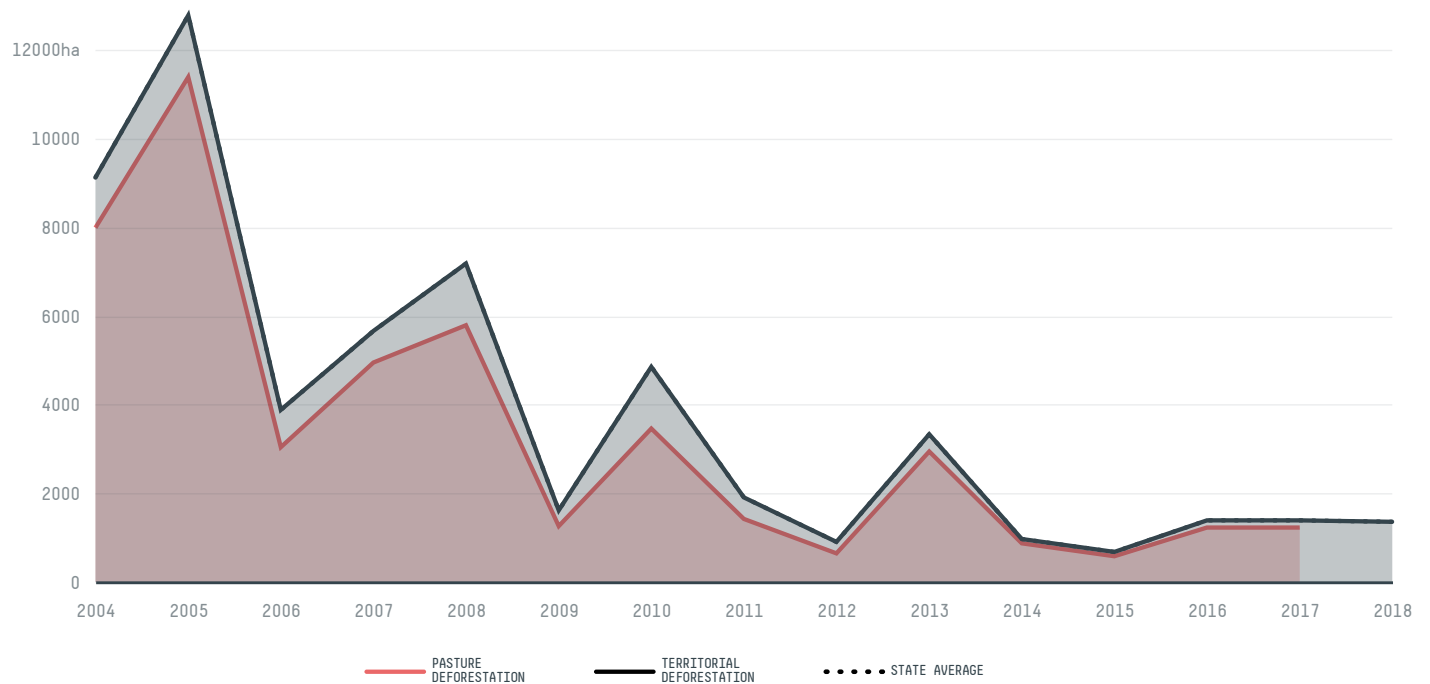

The largest exporter of beef in Tailandia was Mercurio Alimentos, which accounted for 65.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Lebanon.

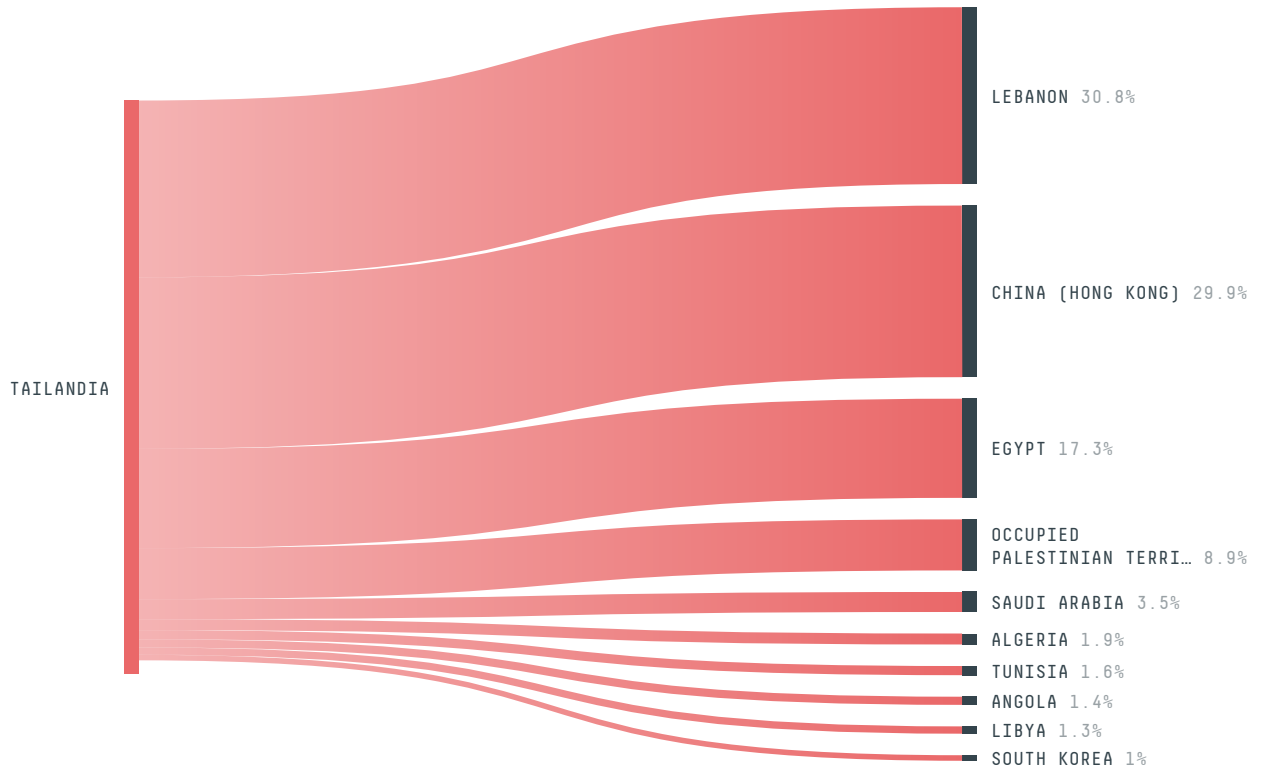

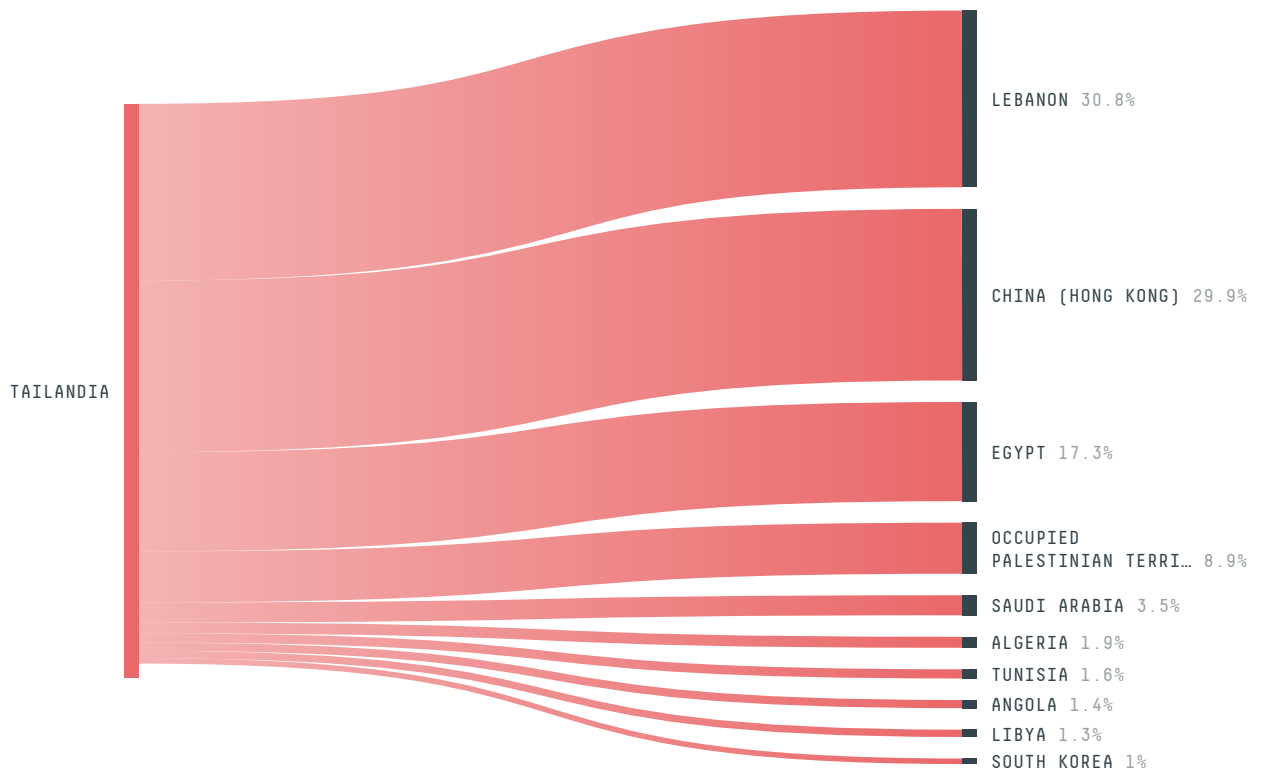
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF TAILANDIA
