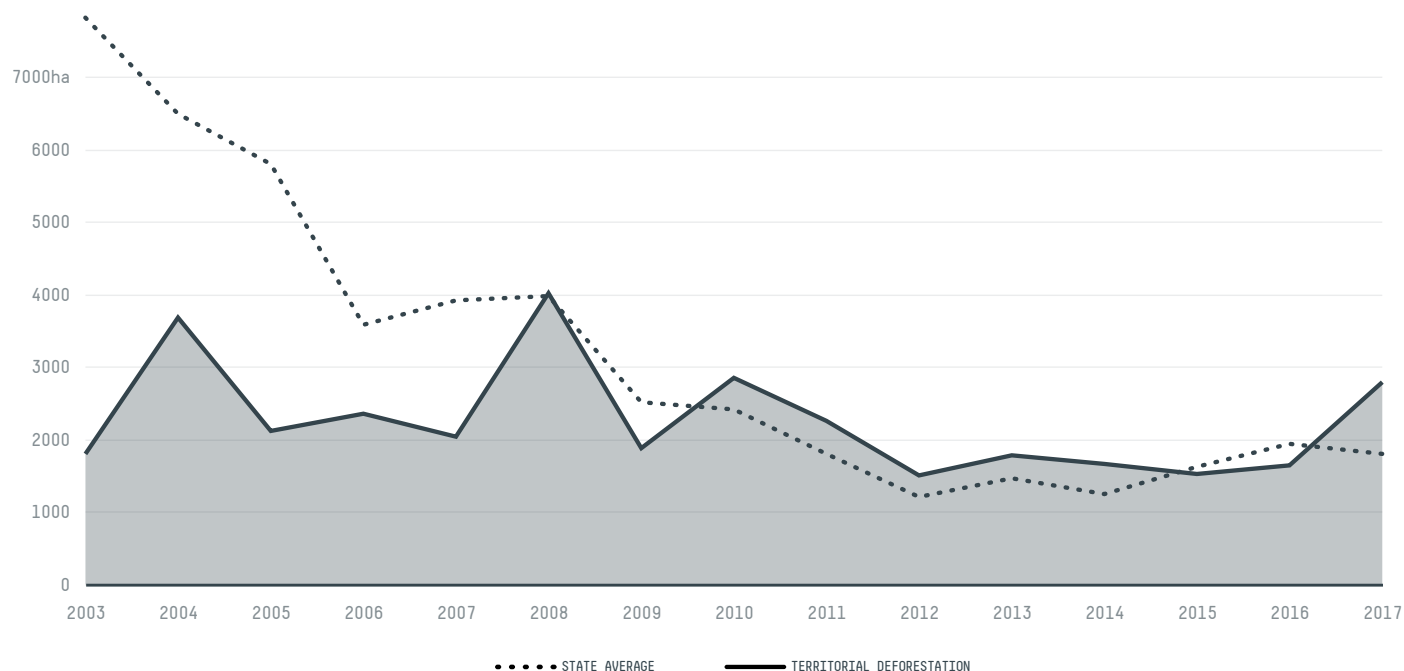

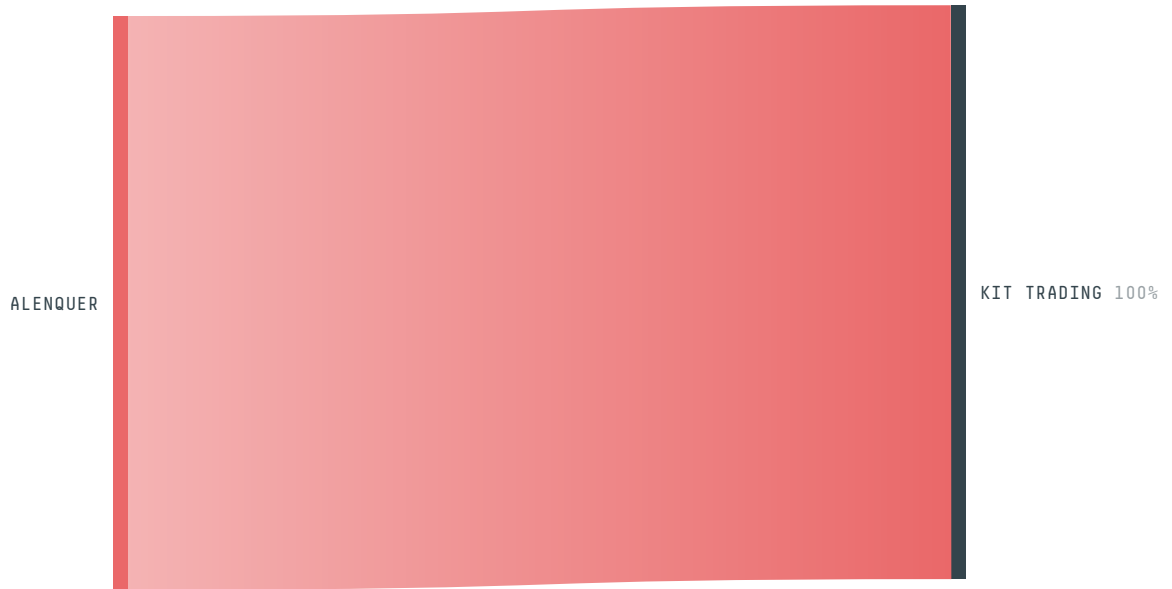

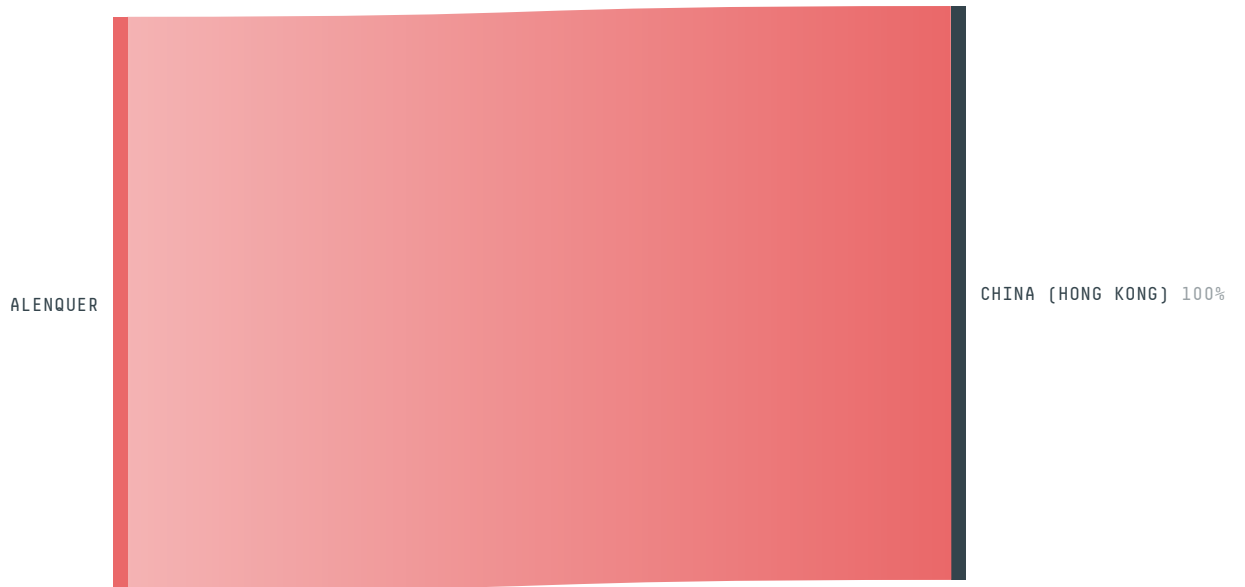
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ALENQUER
