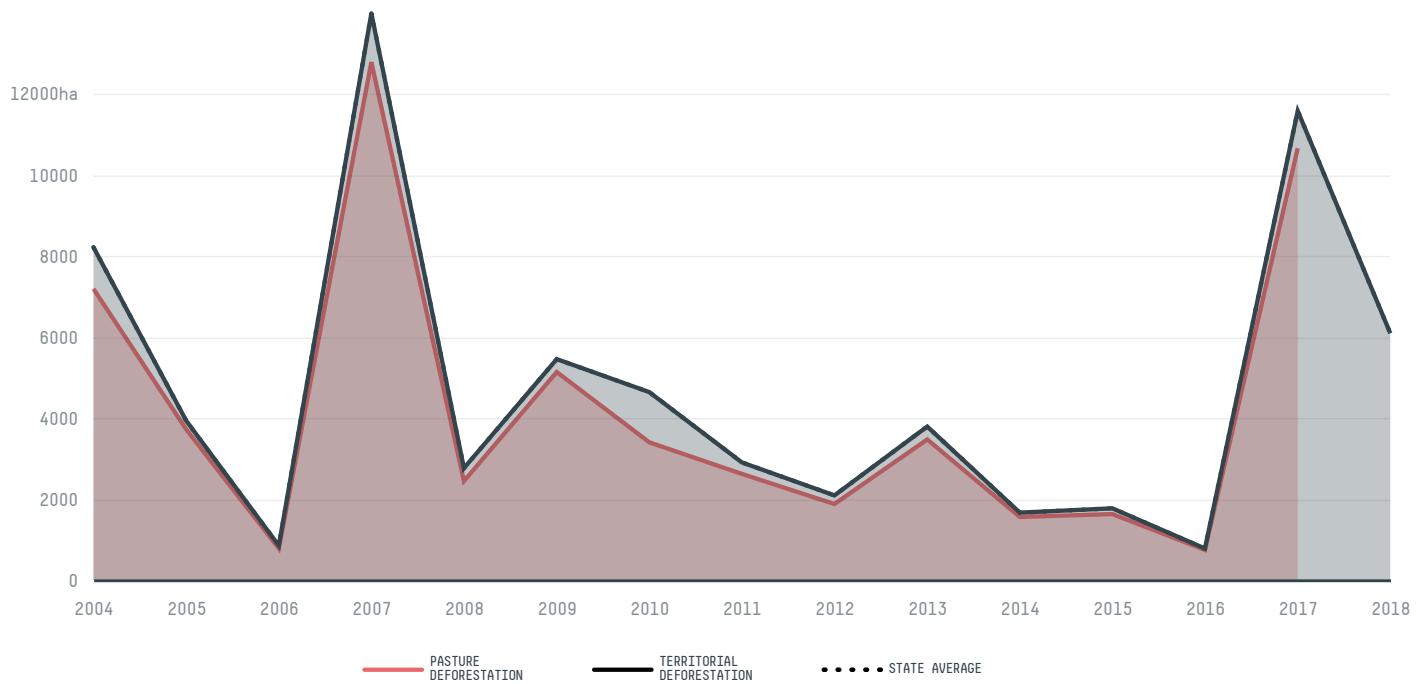

The largest exporter of beef in Medicilandia was Mercurio Alimentos, which accounted for 80.8% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

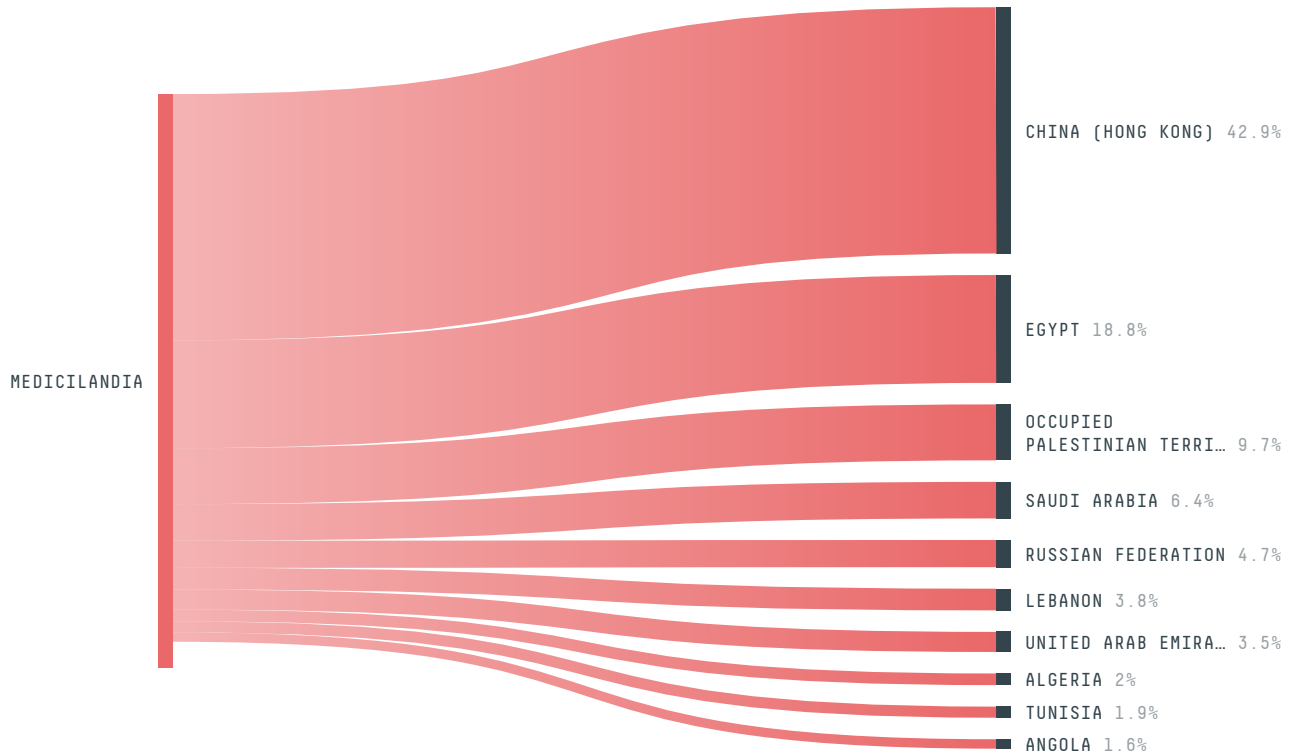

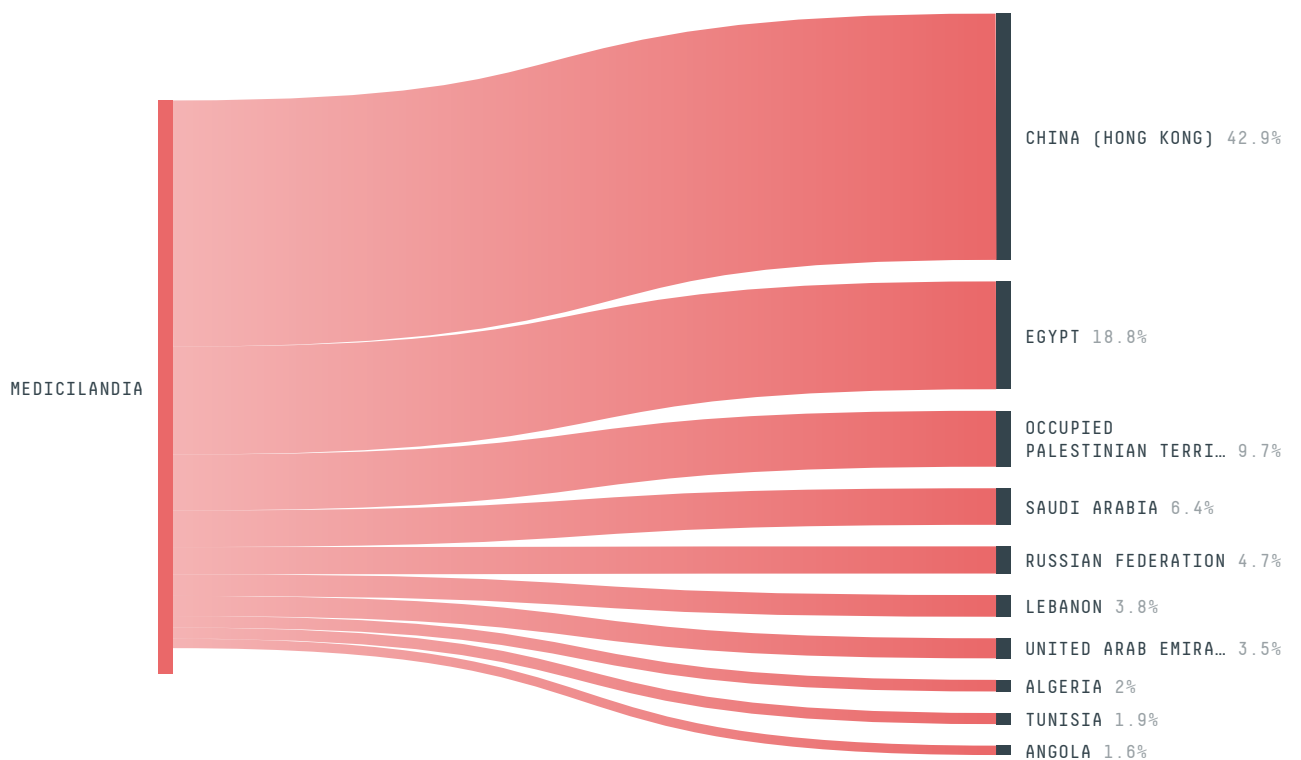
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MEDICILANDIA
