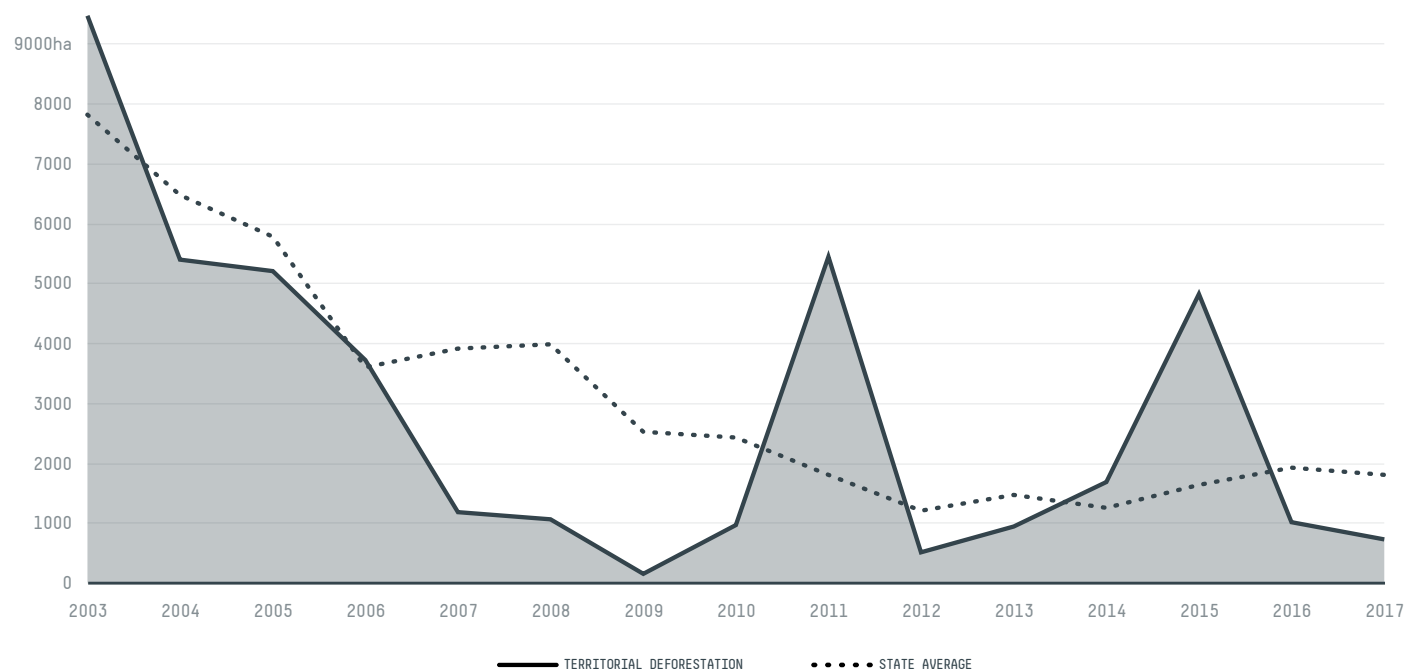

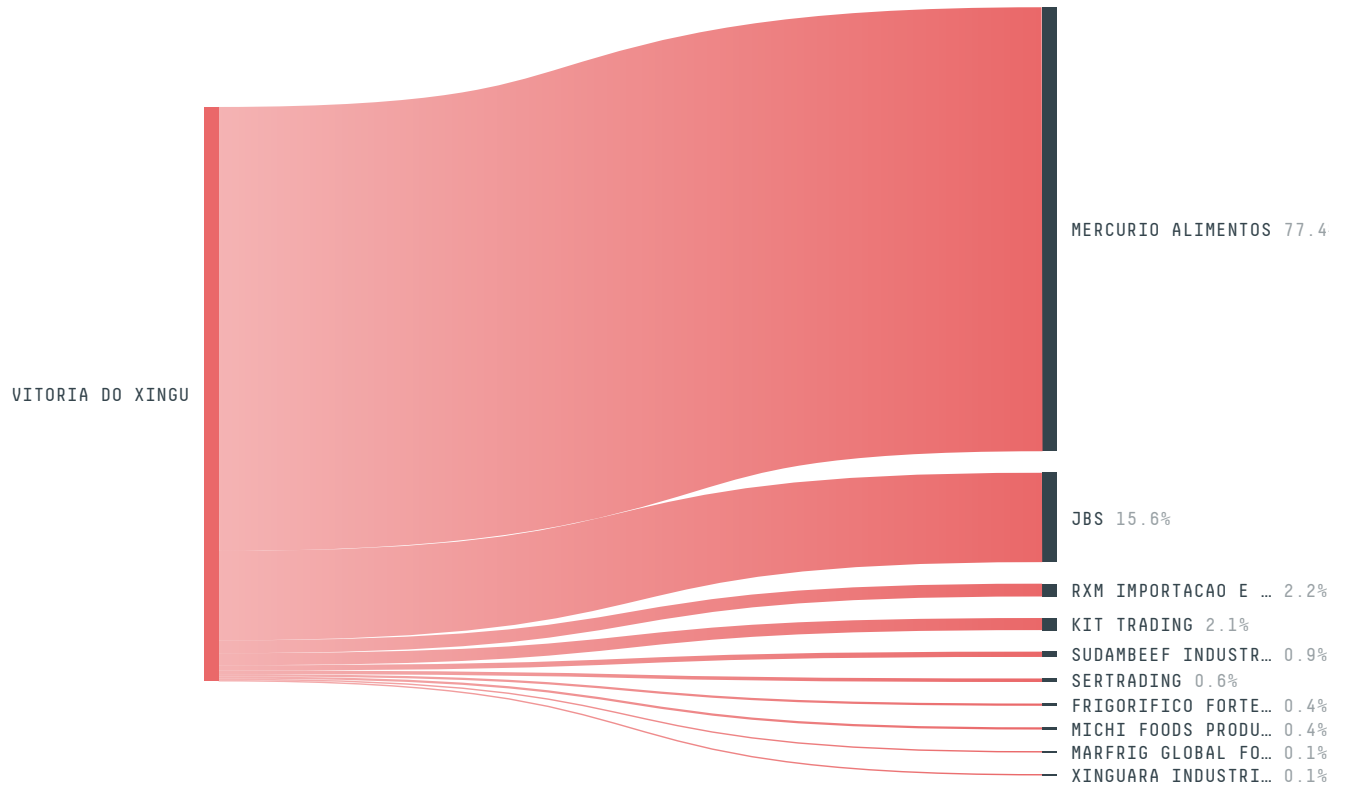

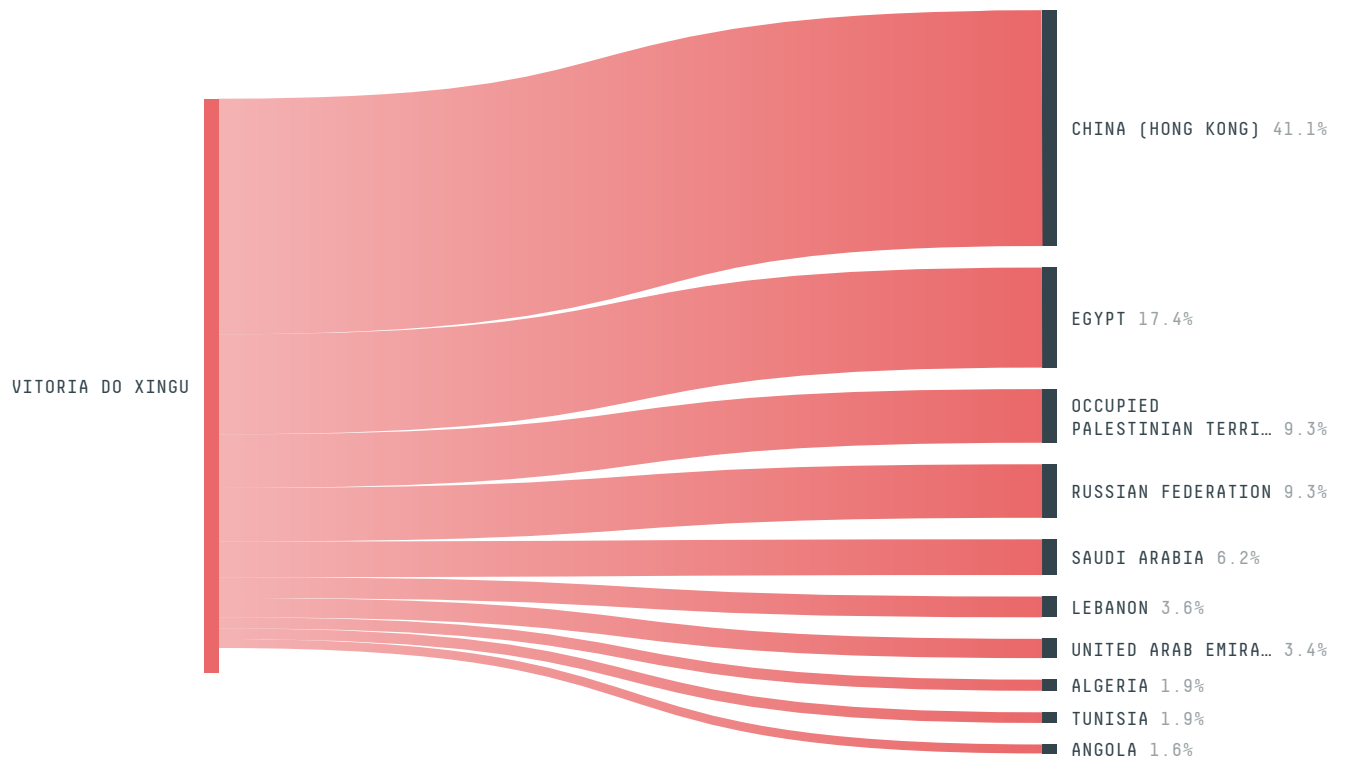
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF VITORIA DO XINGU
