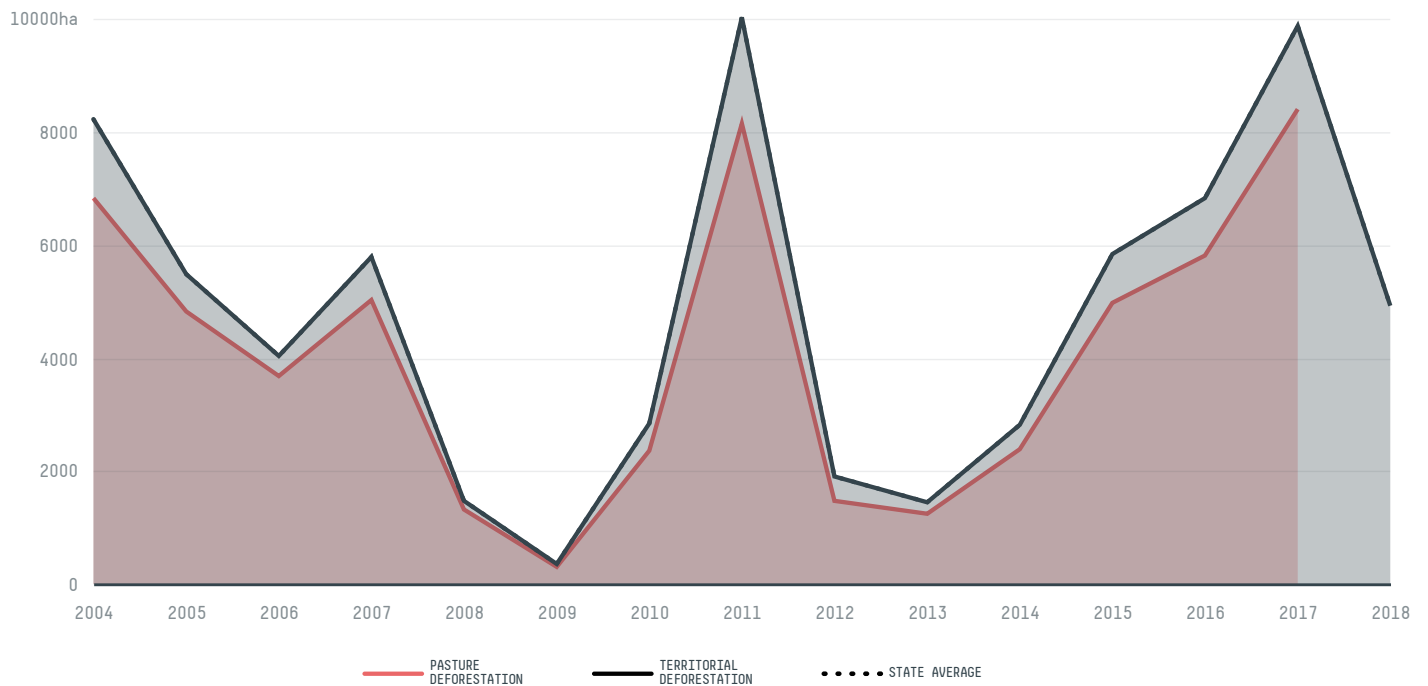

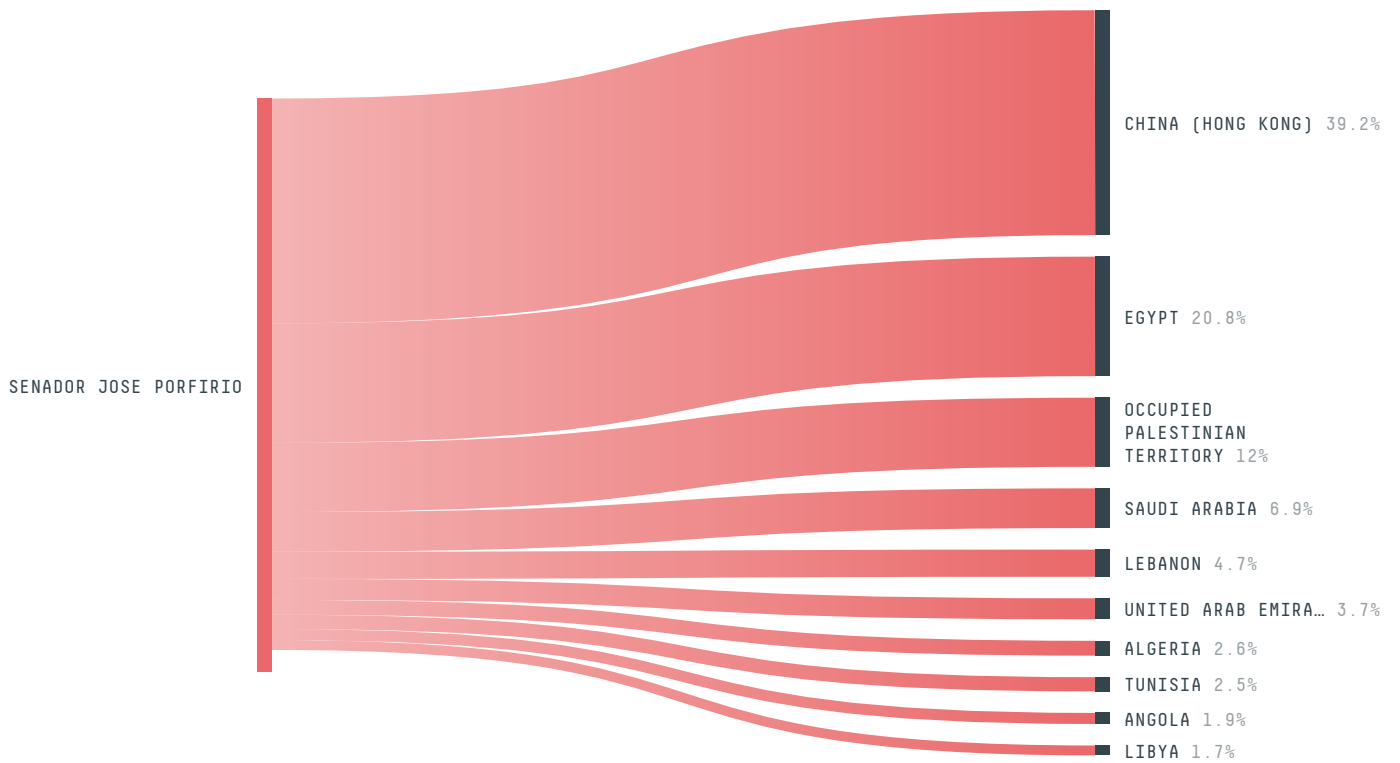

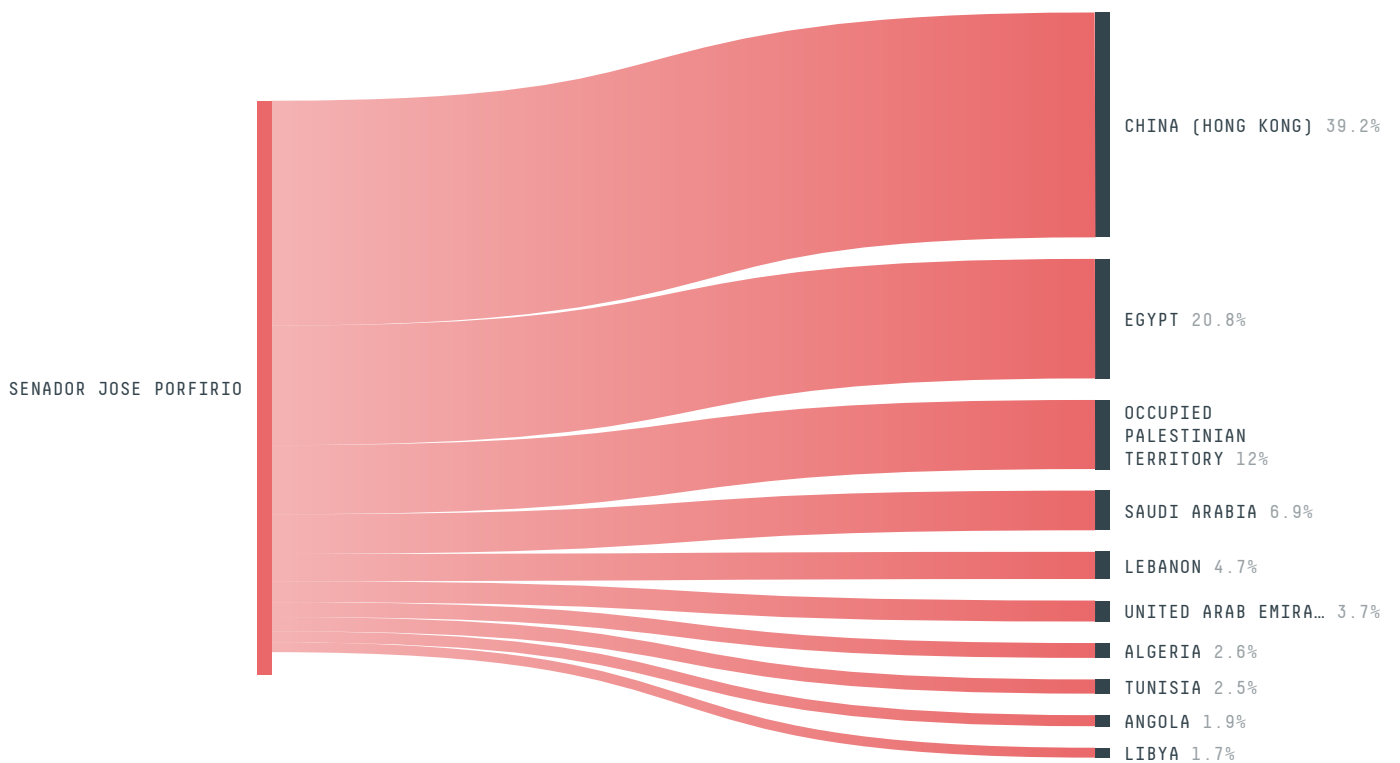
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SENADOR JOSE PORFIRIO
