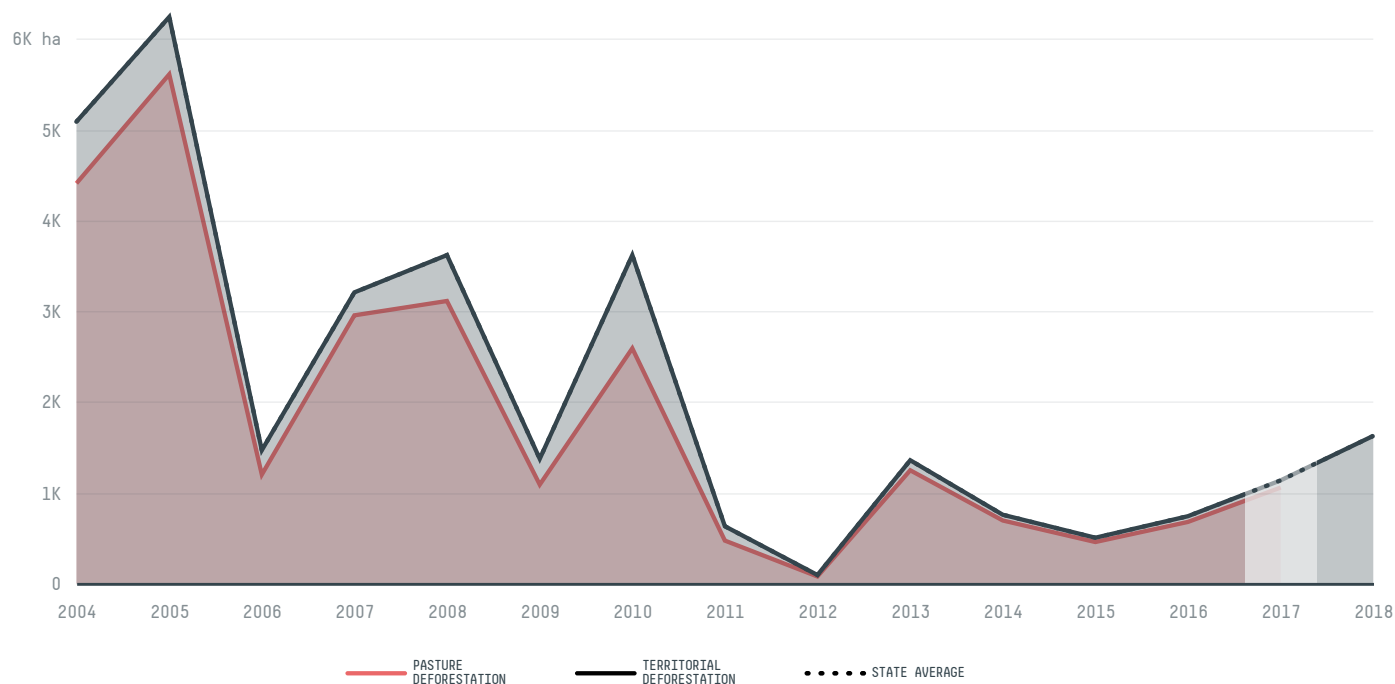

The largest exporter of beef in Tome Acu was Kit Trading, which accounted for 29.9% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).

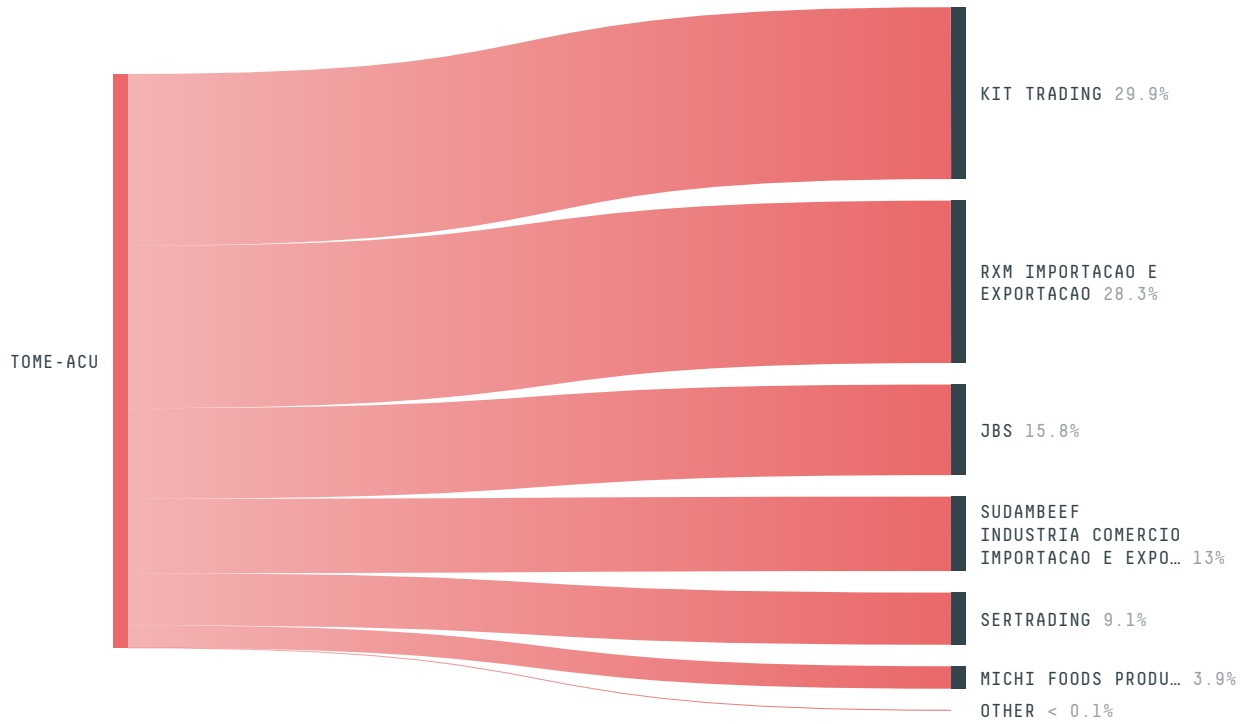

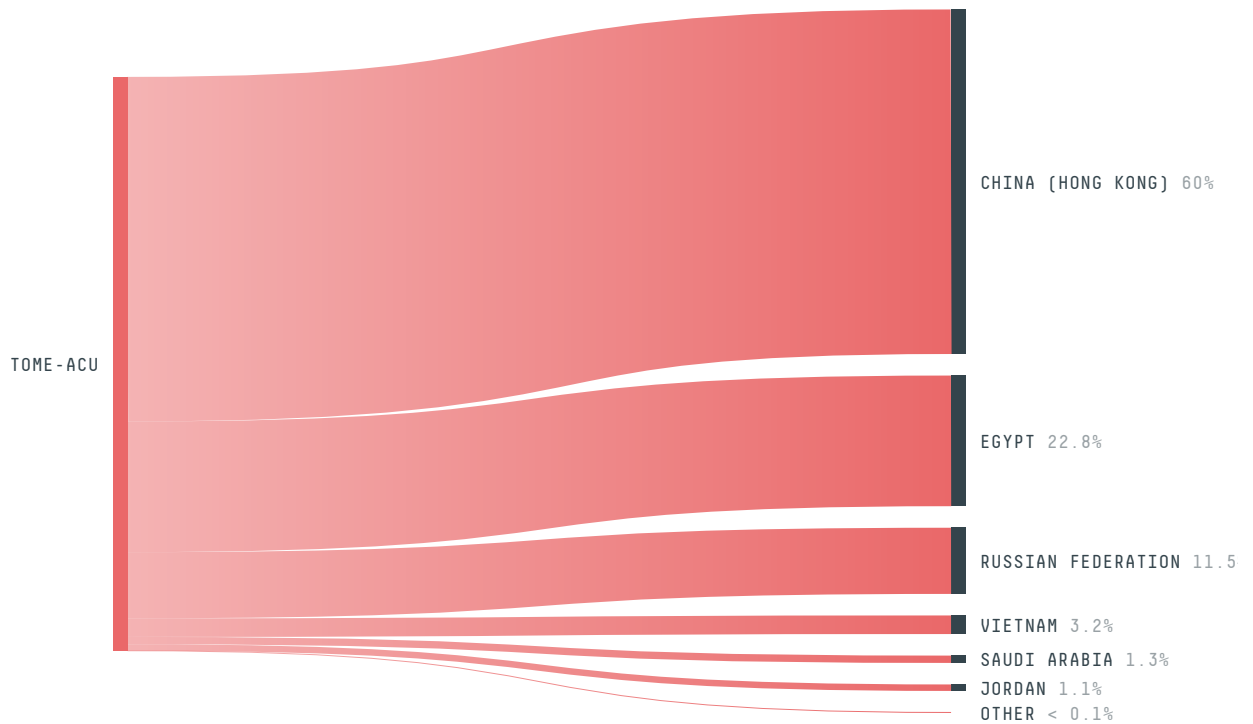
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF TOME-ACU
