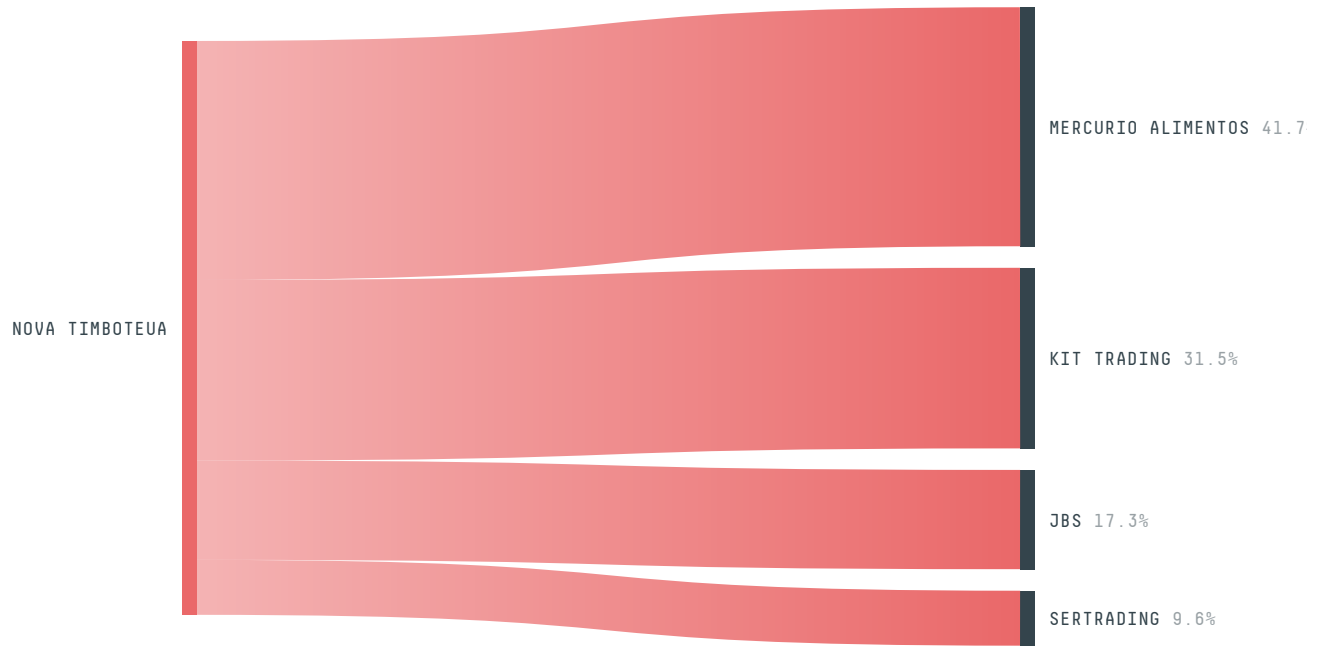

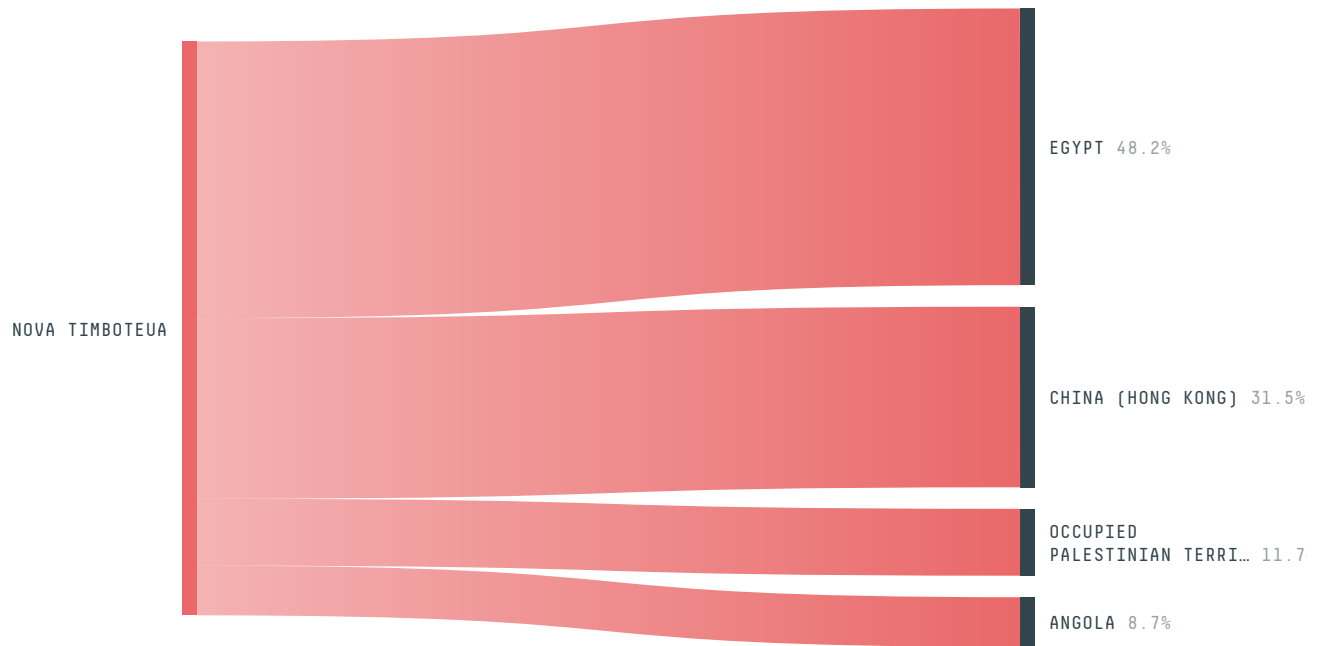
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NOVA TIMBOTEUA
