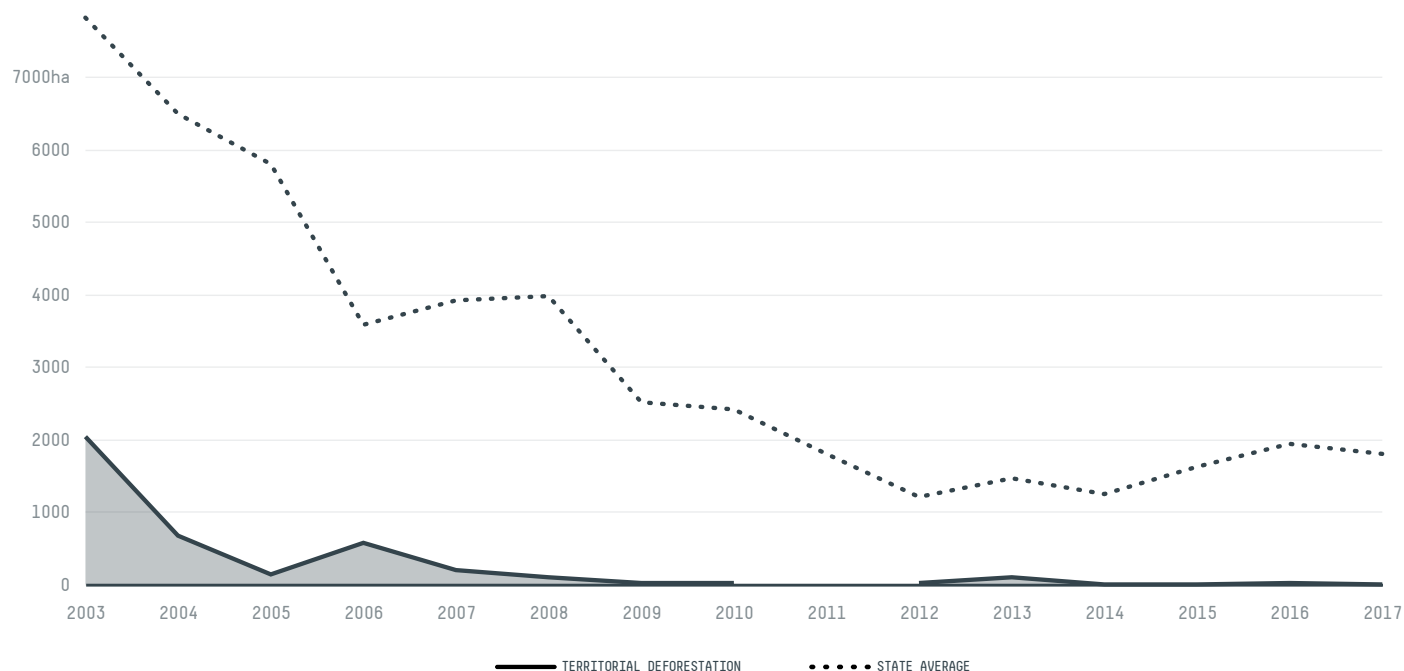
The largest exporter of beef in Santa Maria Do Para was Kit Trading, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Hong Kong).
