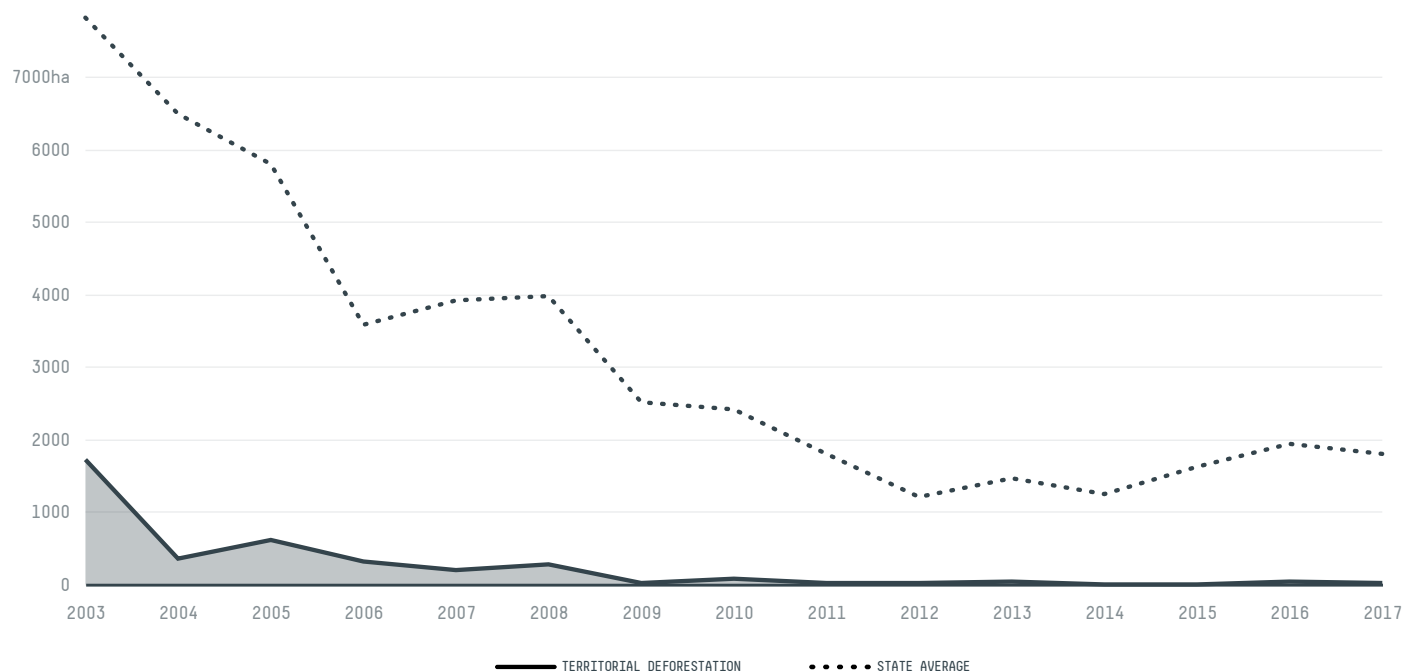

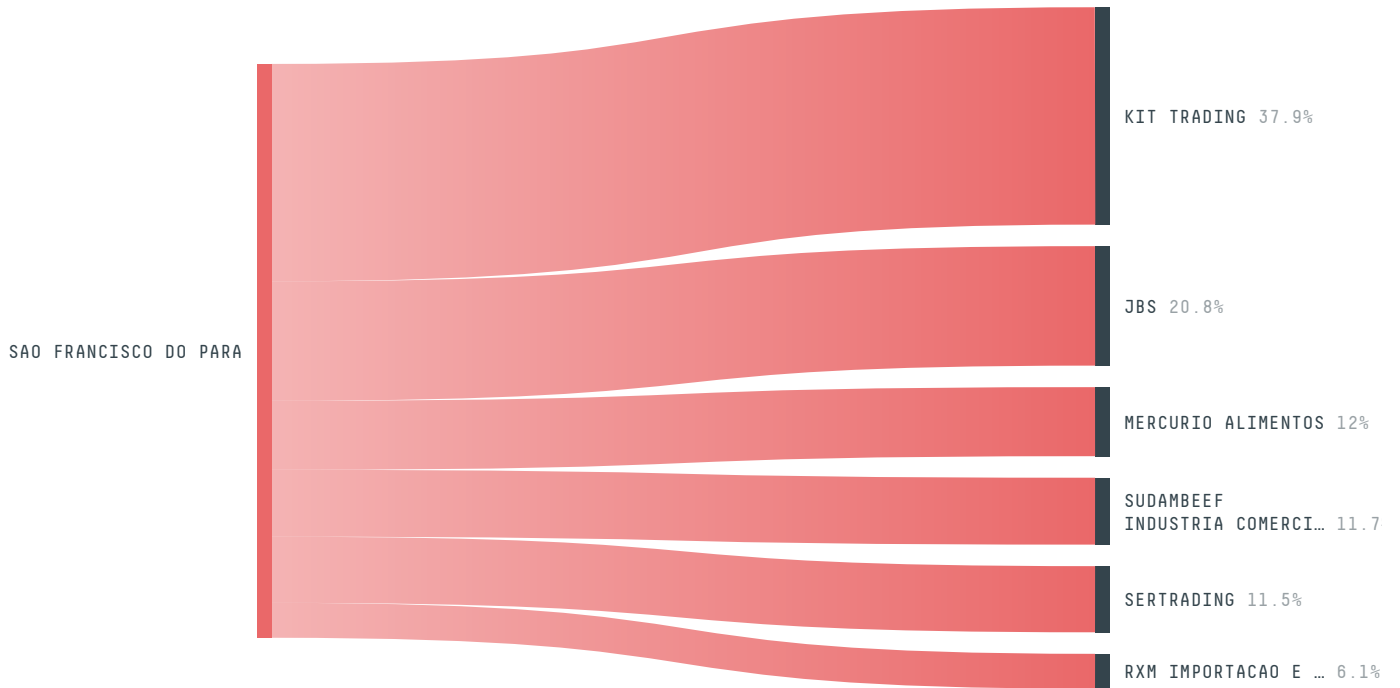

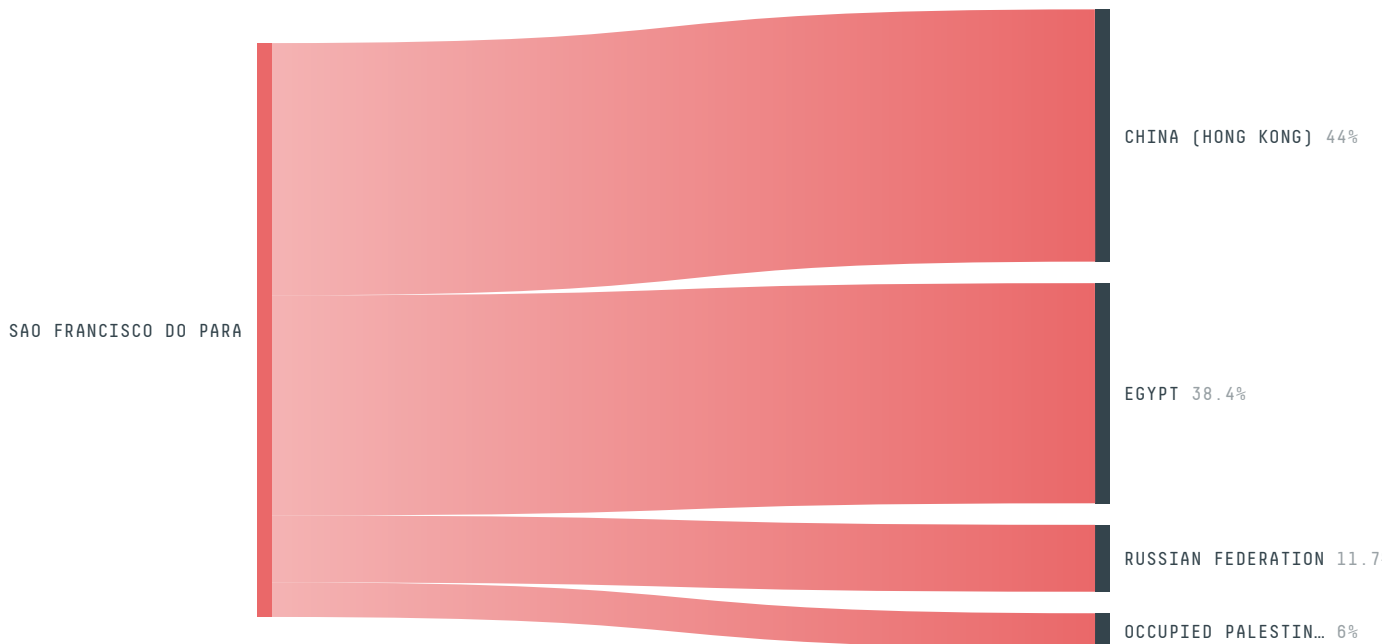
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SAO FRANCISCO DO PARA
