The largest exporter of beef in Trairao was Jbs, which accounted for 67.3% of the total exports, and the main destination was Russian Federation.

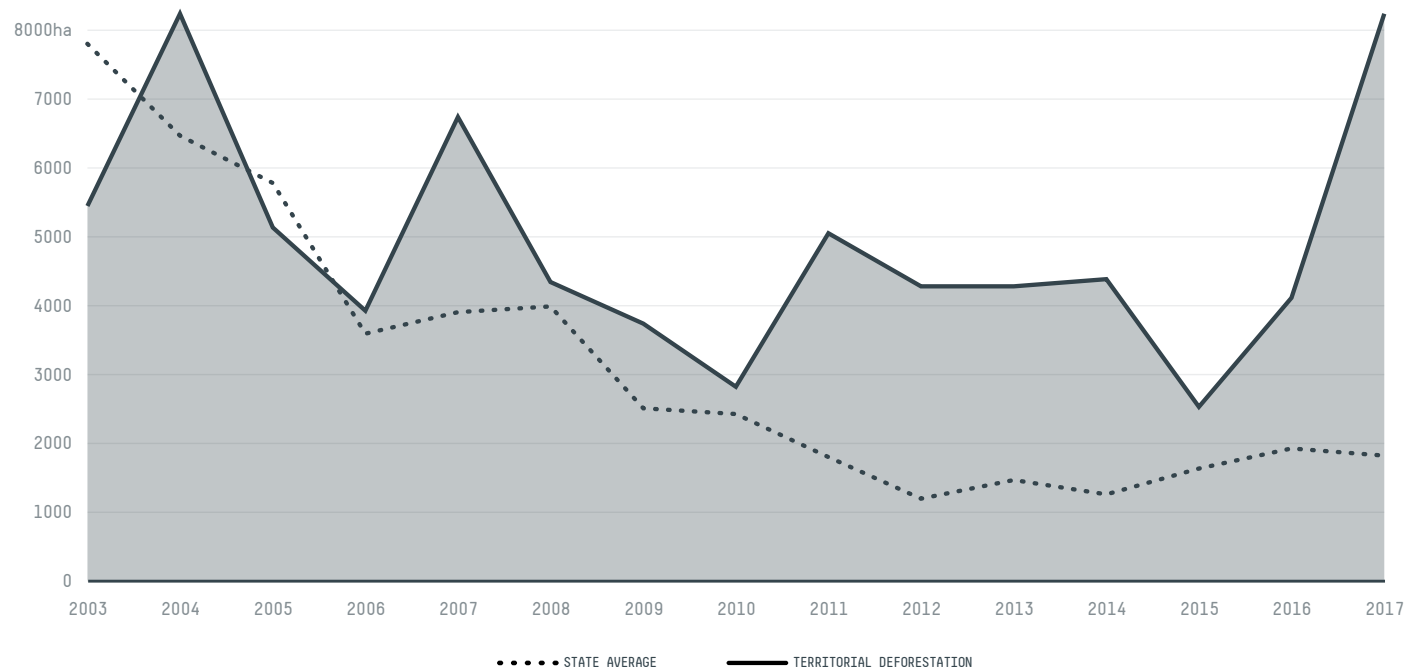

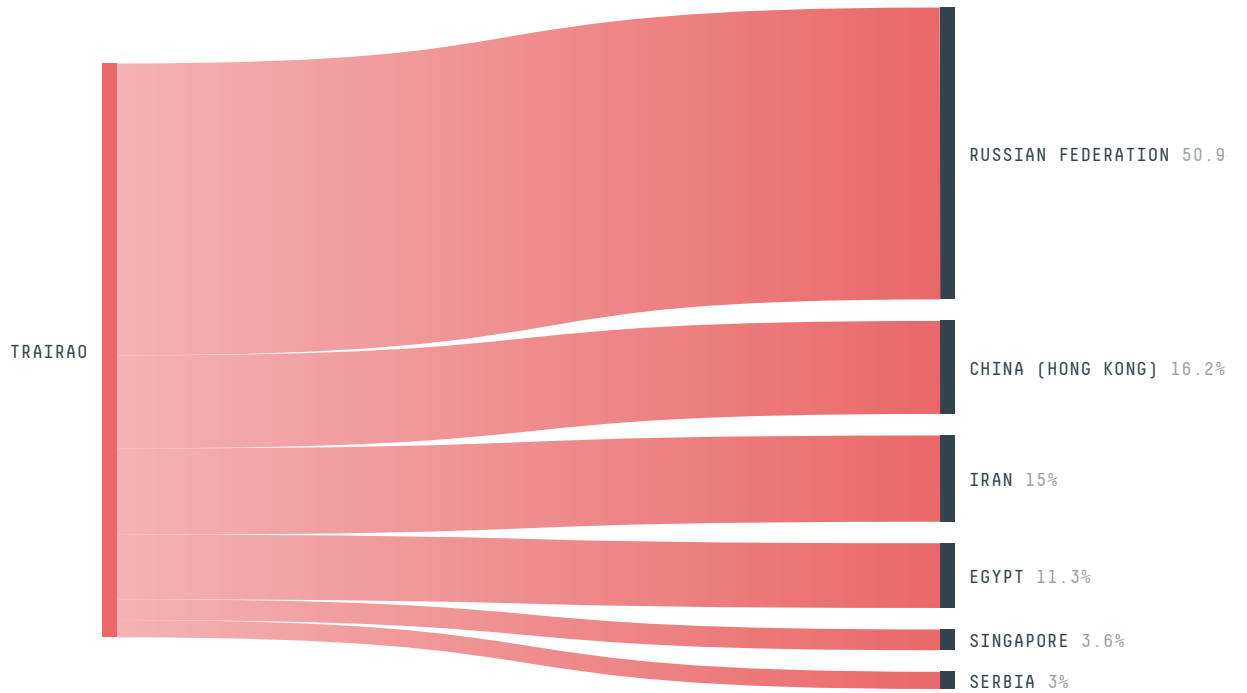
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF TRAIRAO
