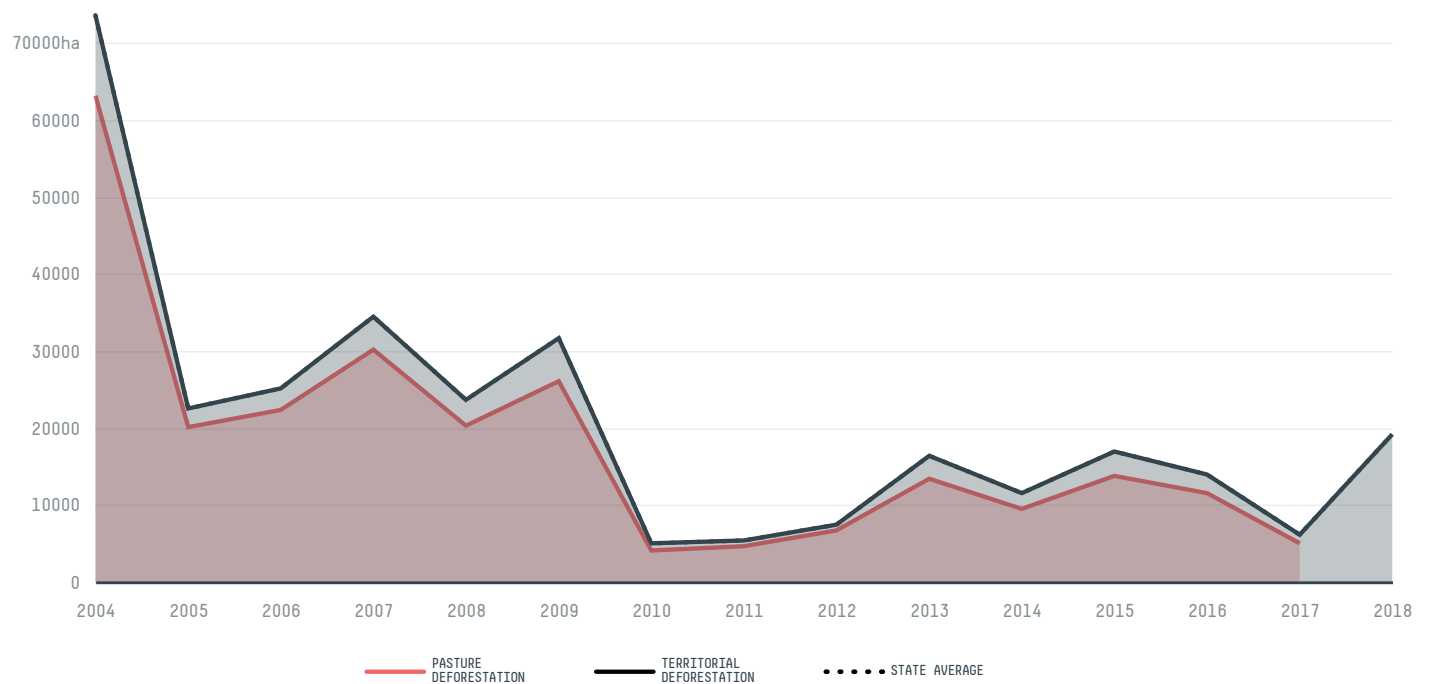

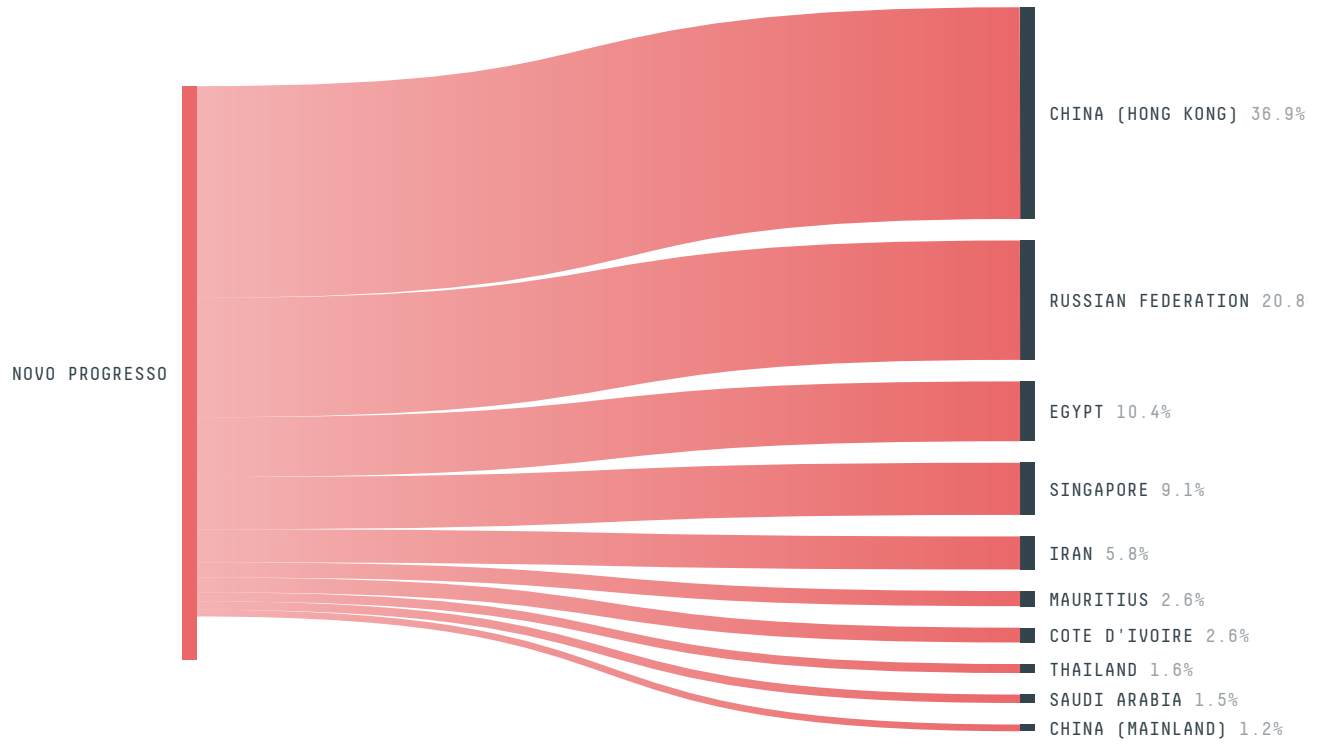

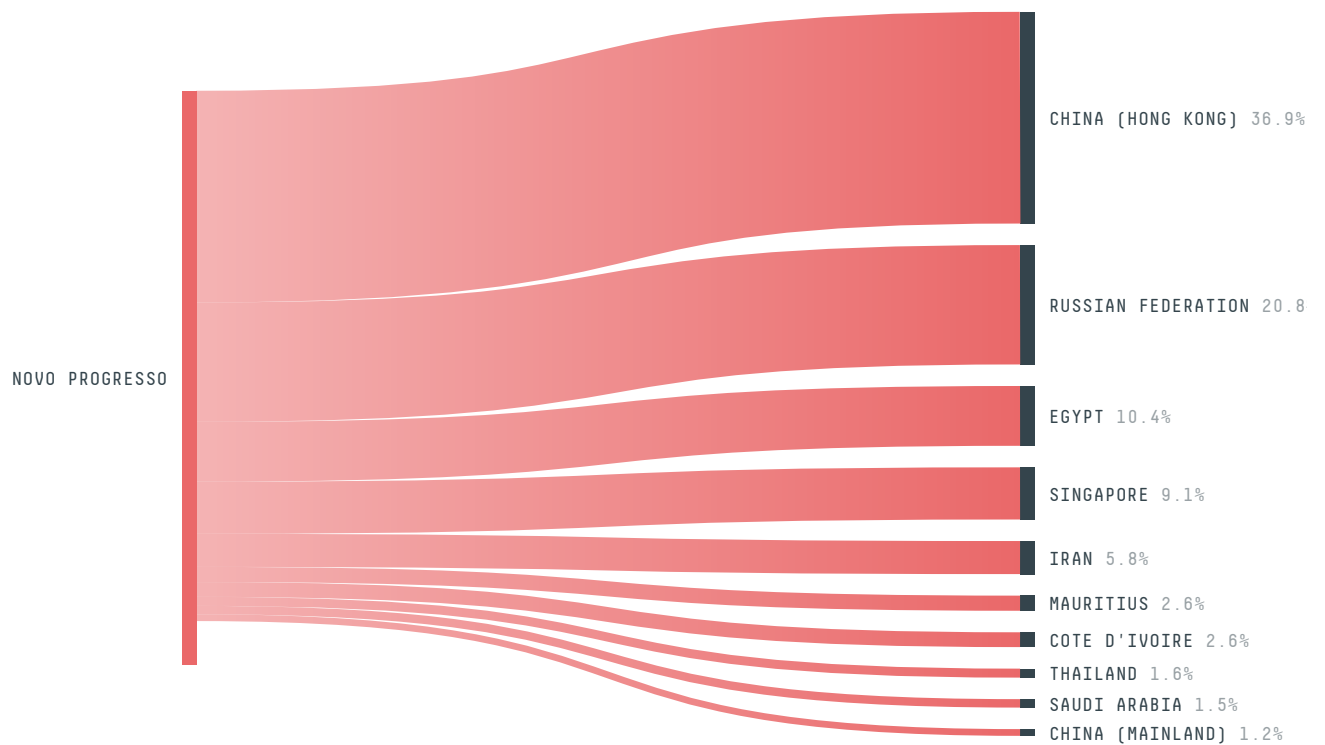
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NOVO PROGRESSO
