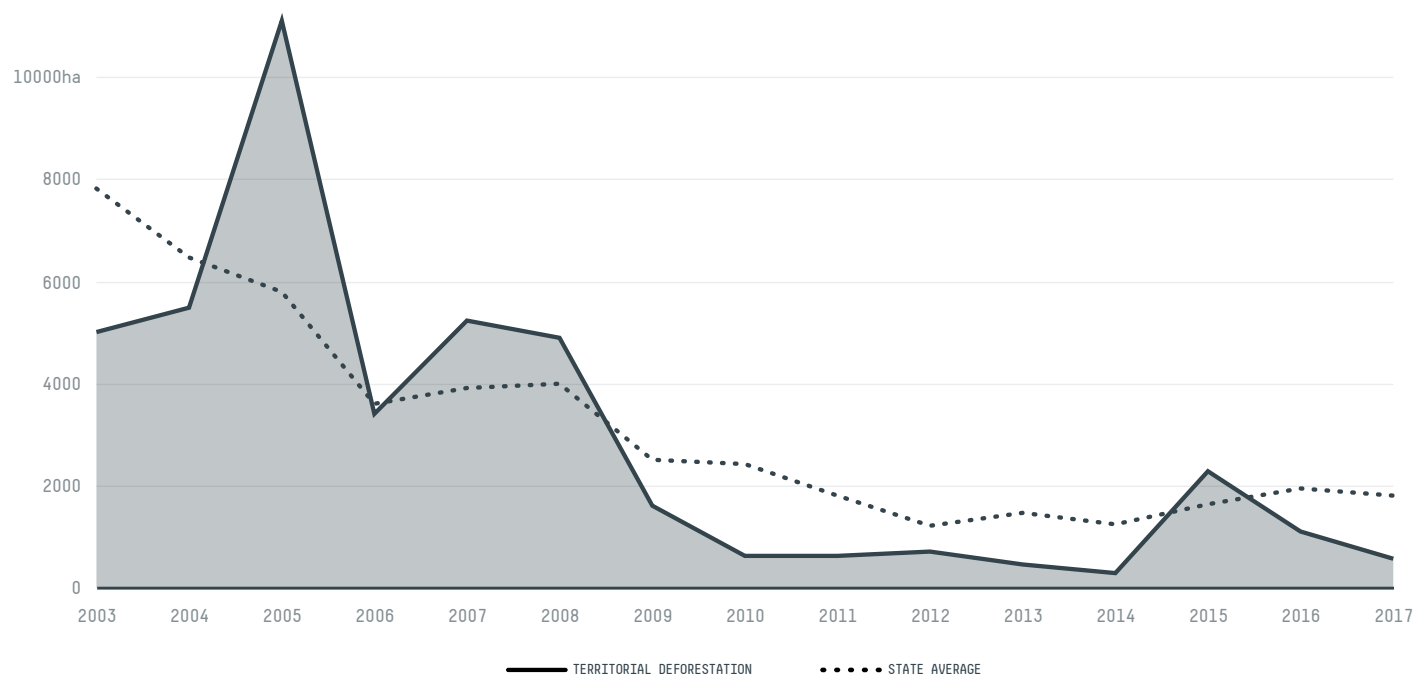

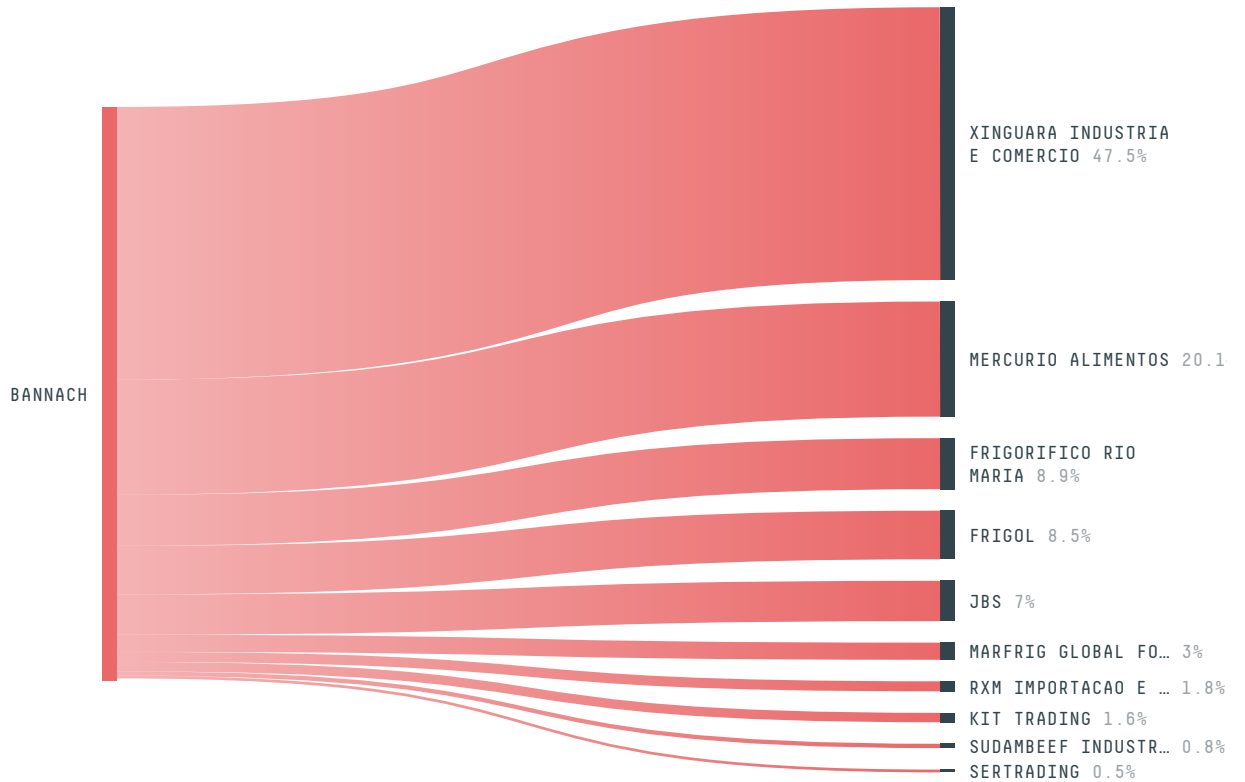

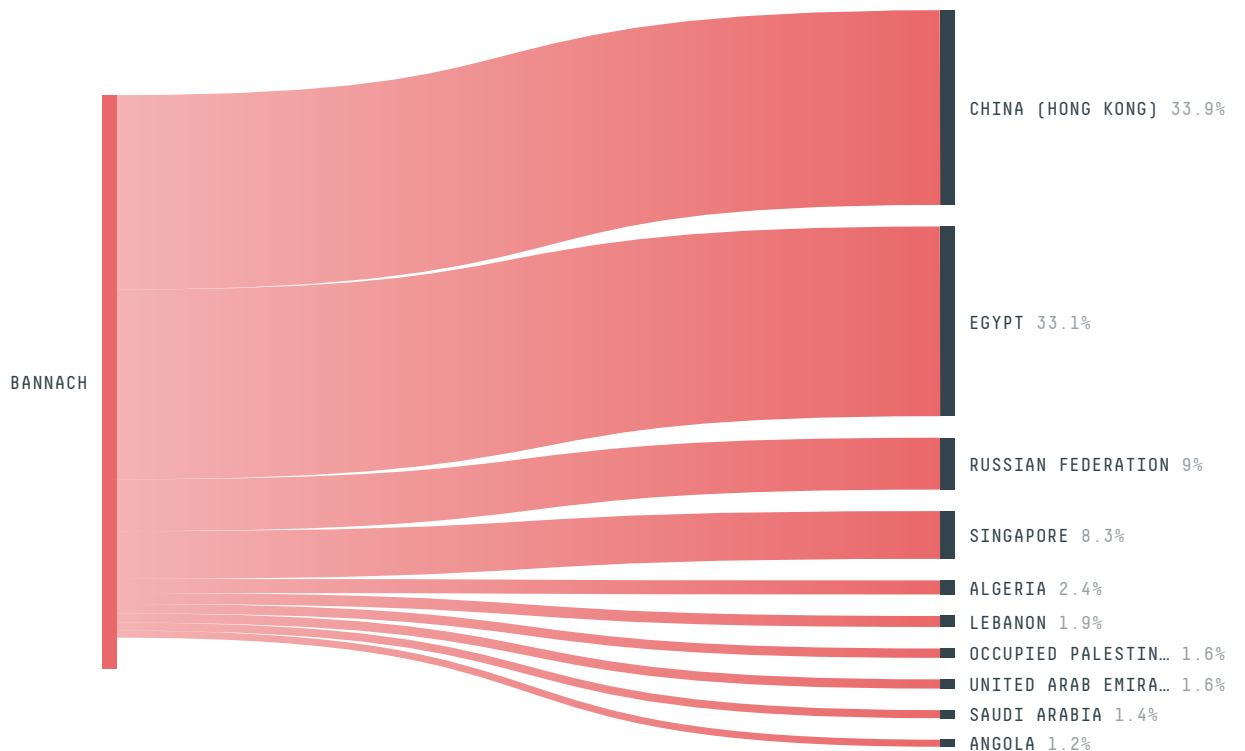
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BANNACH

## TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF BEEF FROM BANNACH IN 2017



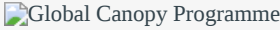


**Deforestation alerts in Bannach, Pará, Brazil**

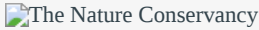
