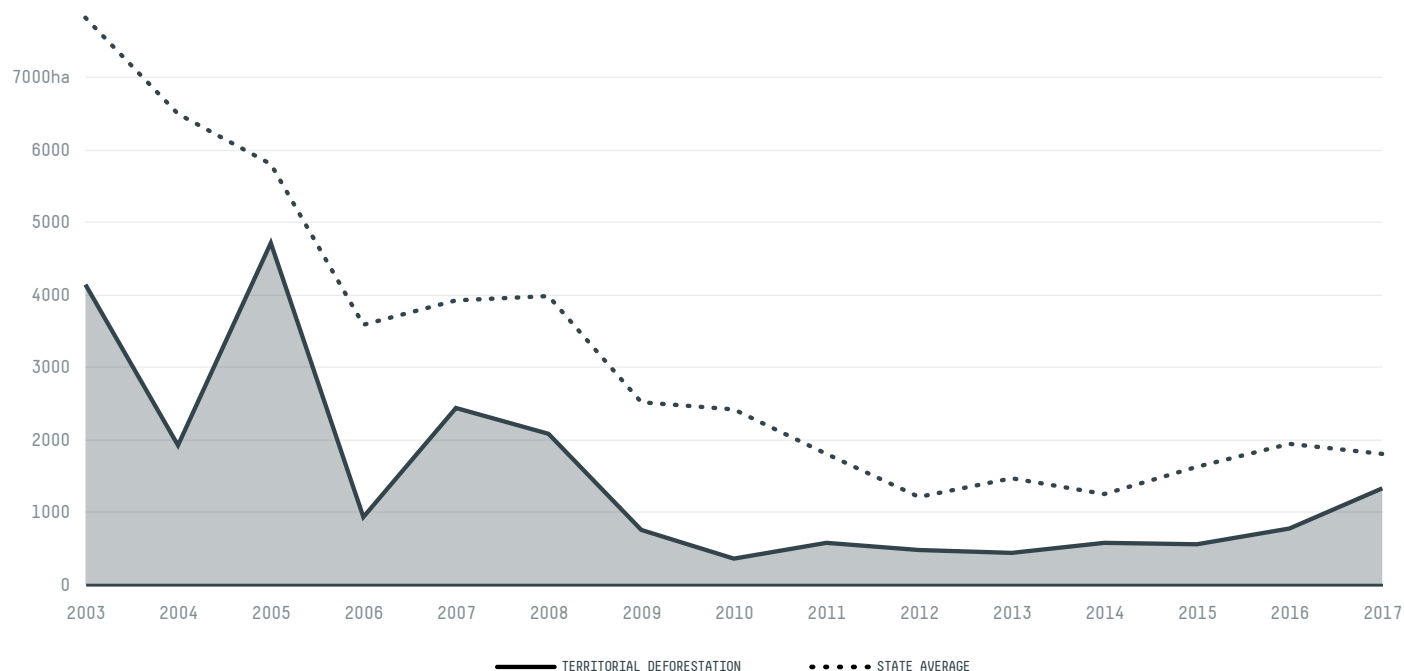

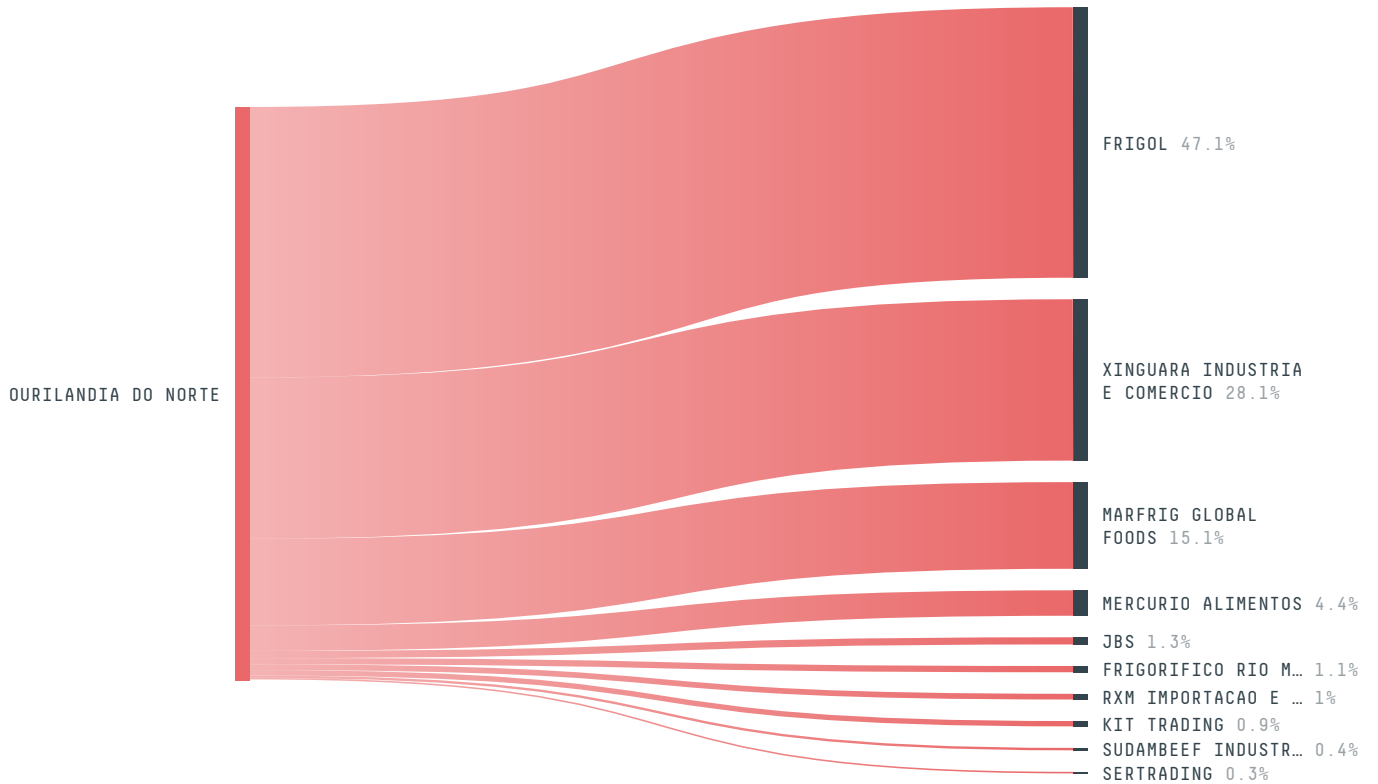

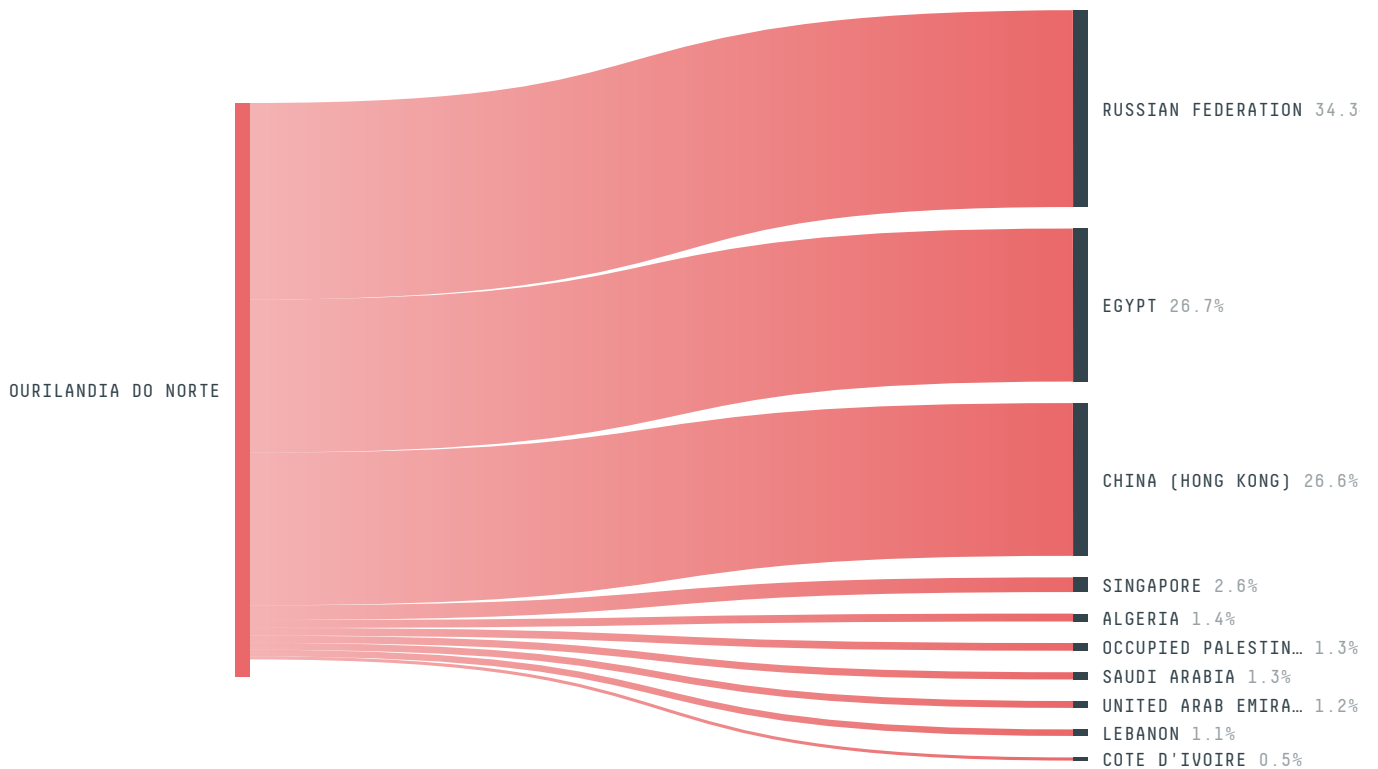
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF OURILANDIA DO NORTE
