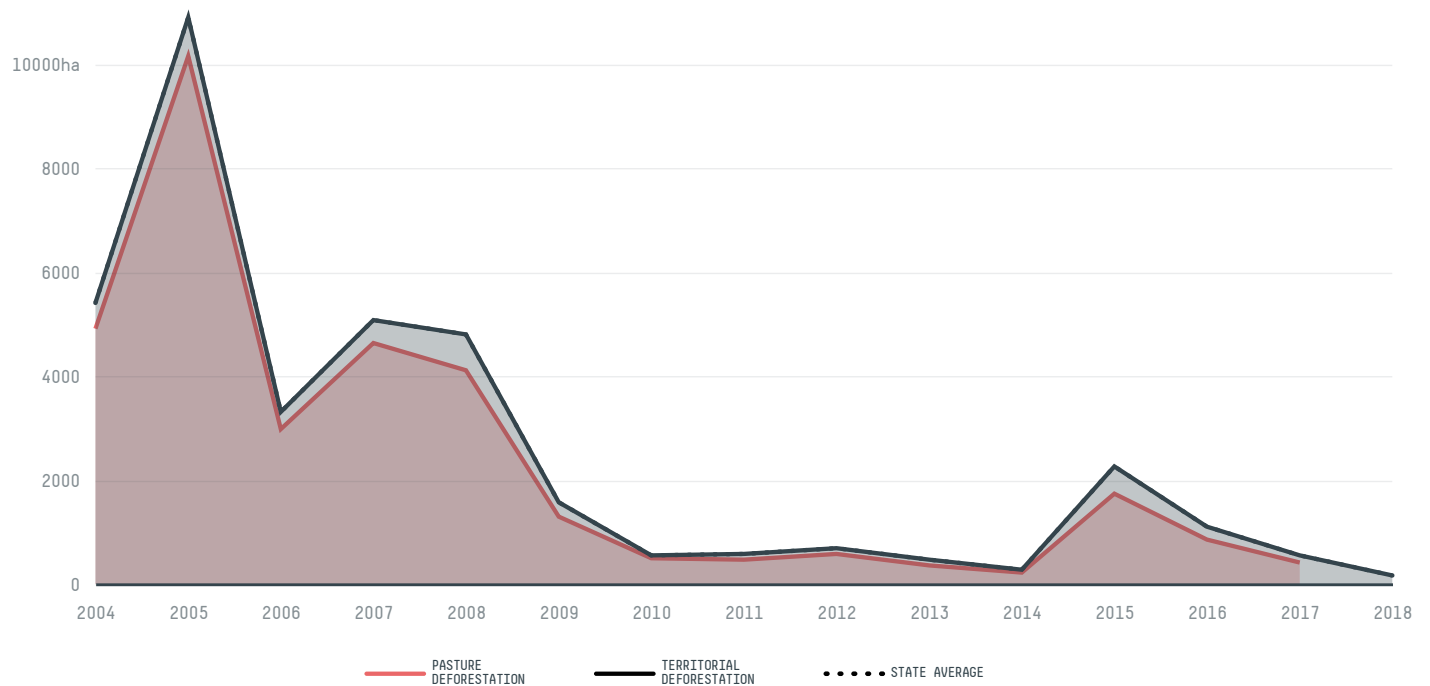

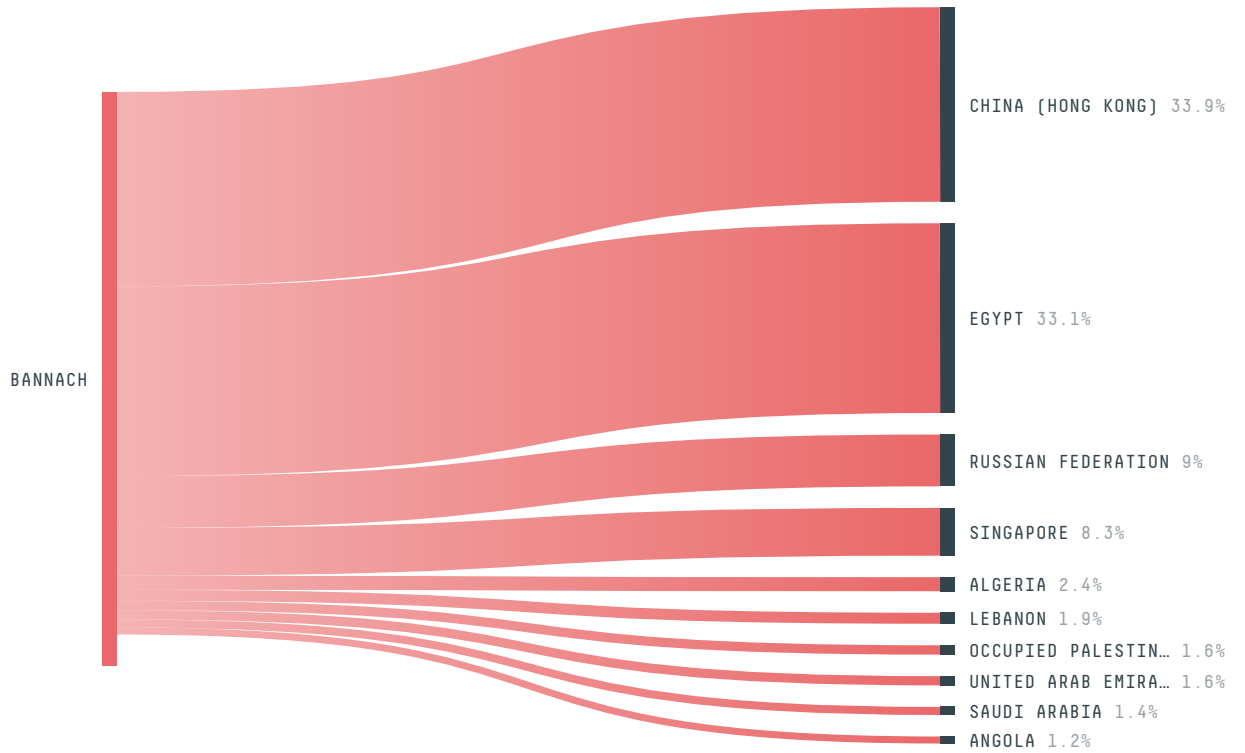

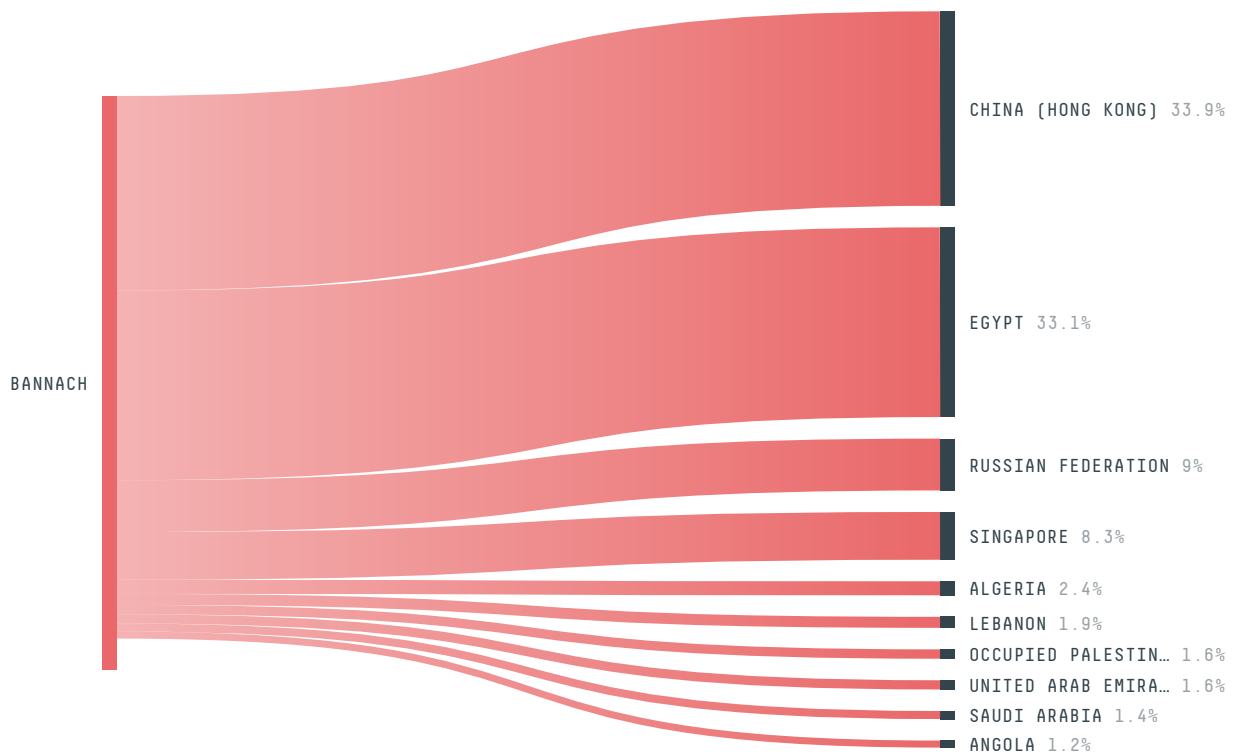
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF BANNACH
