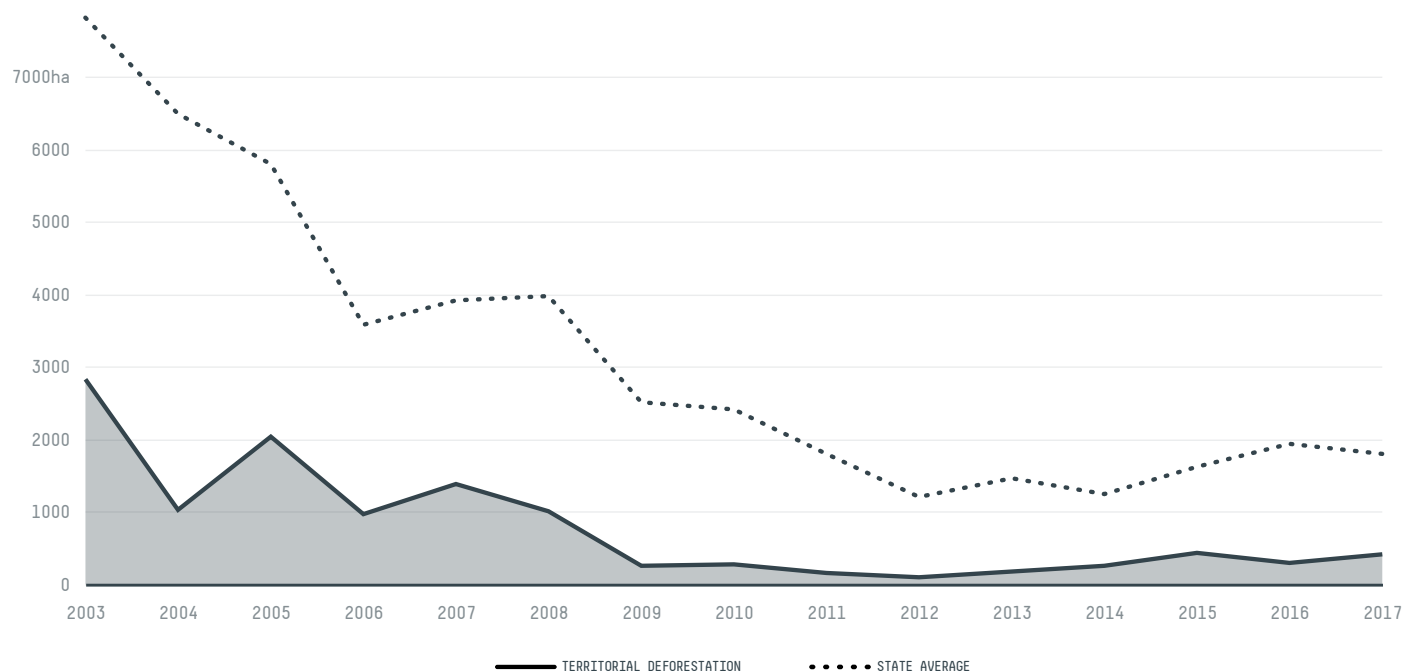

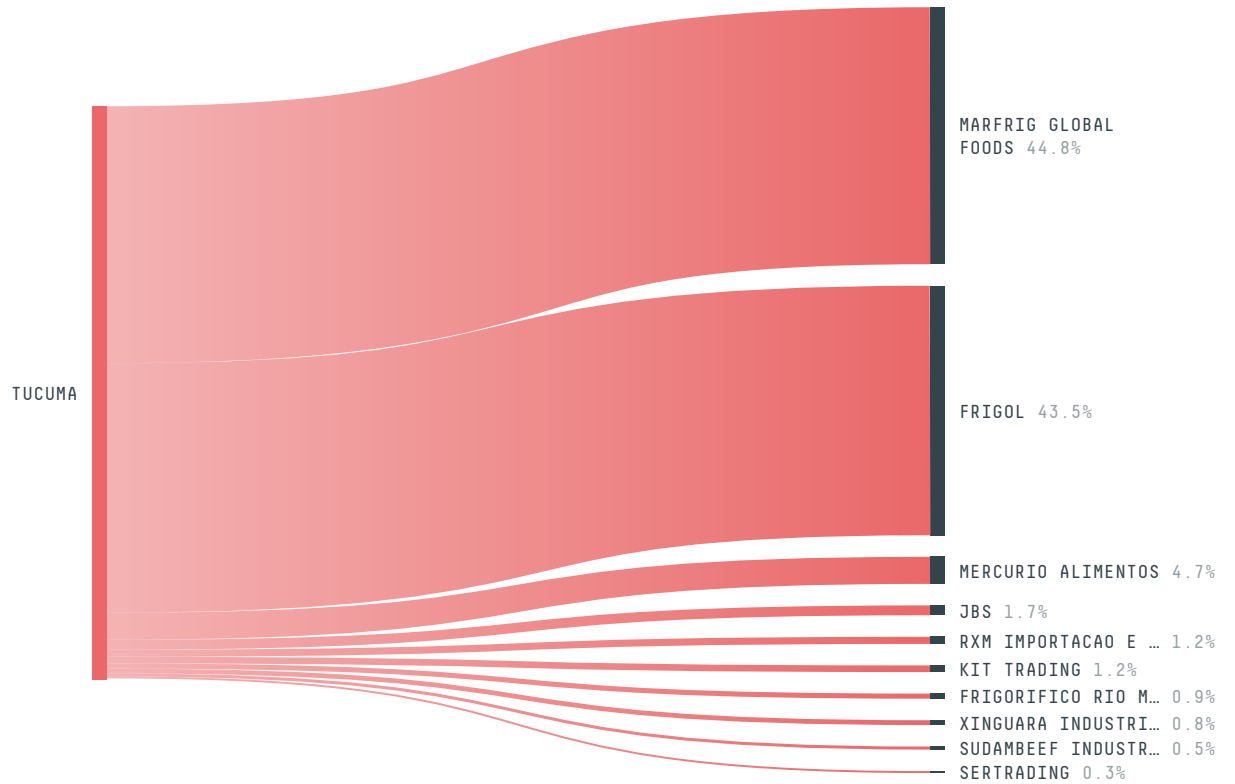

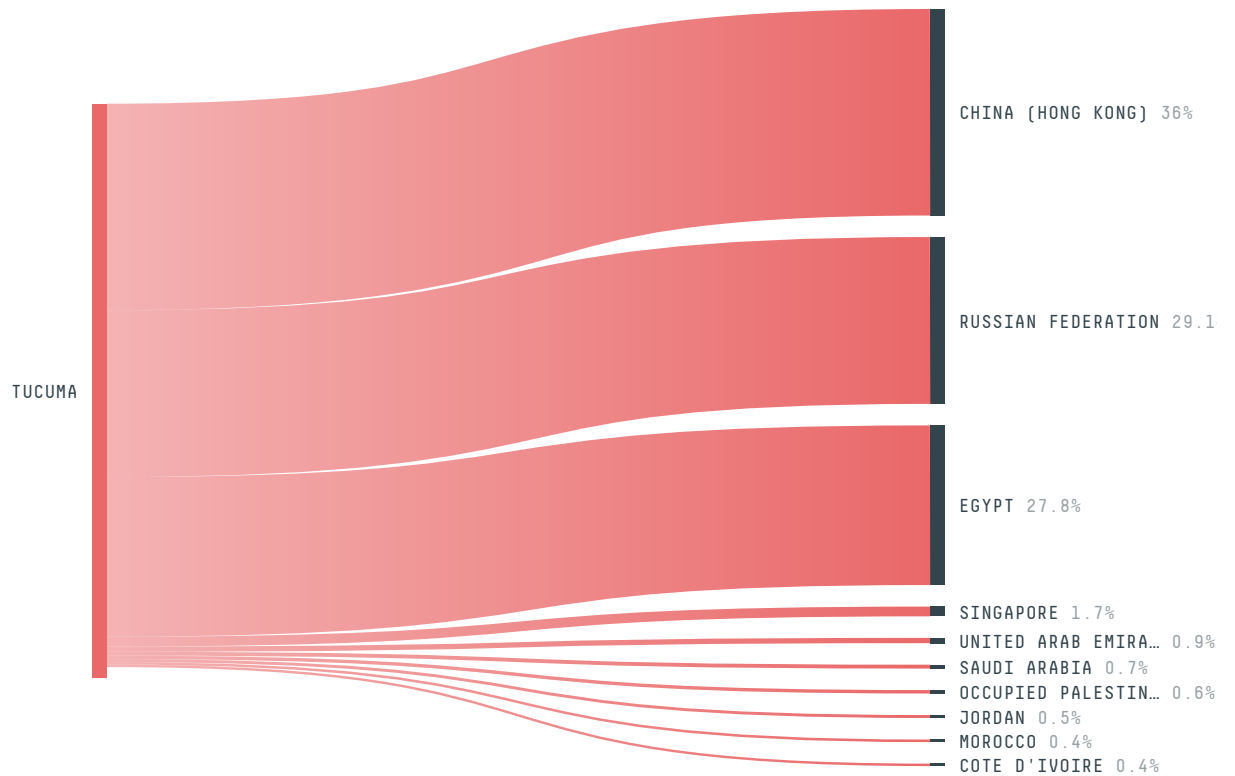
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF TUCUMA
