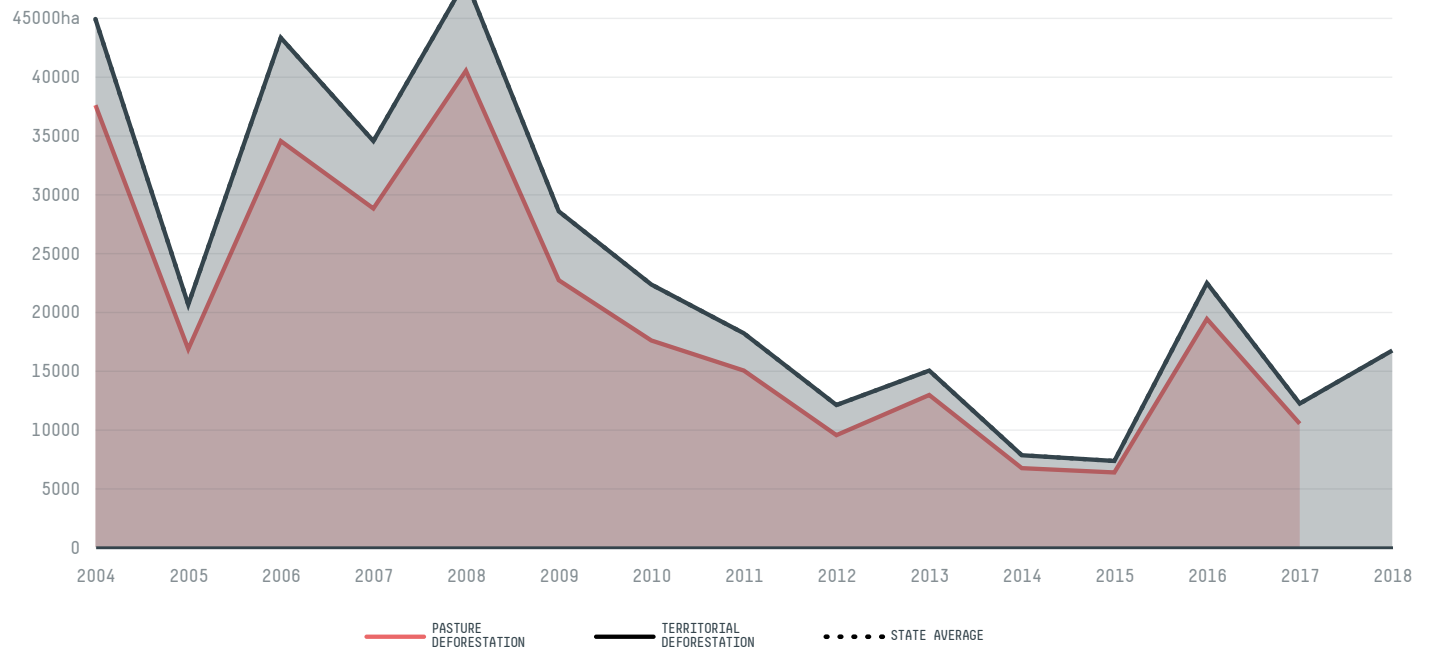

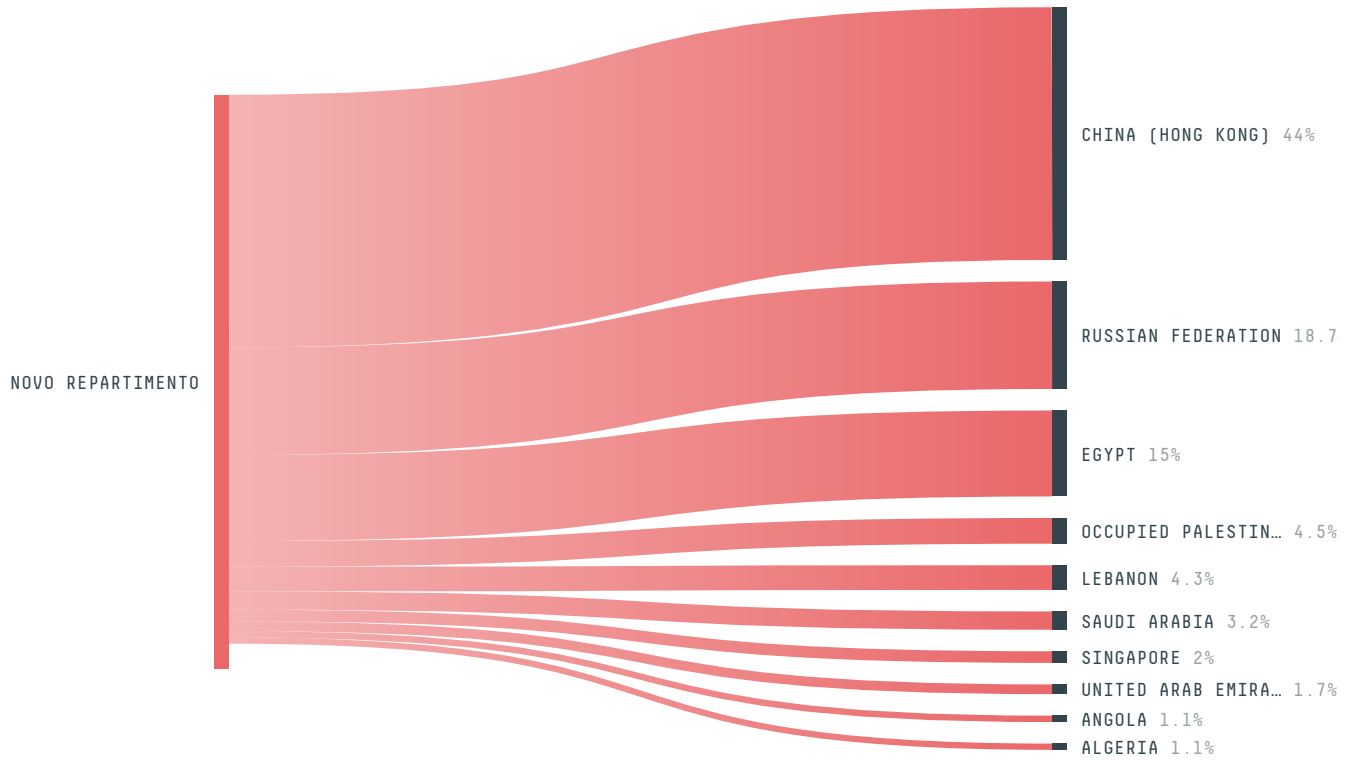

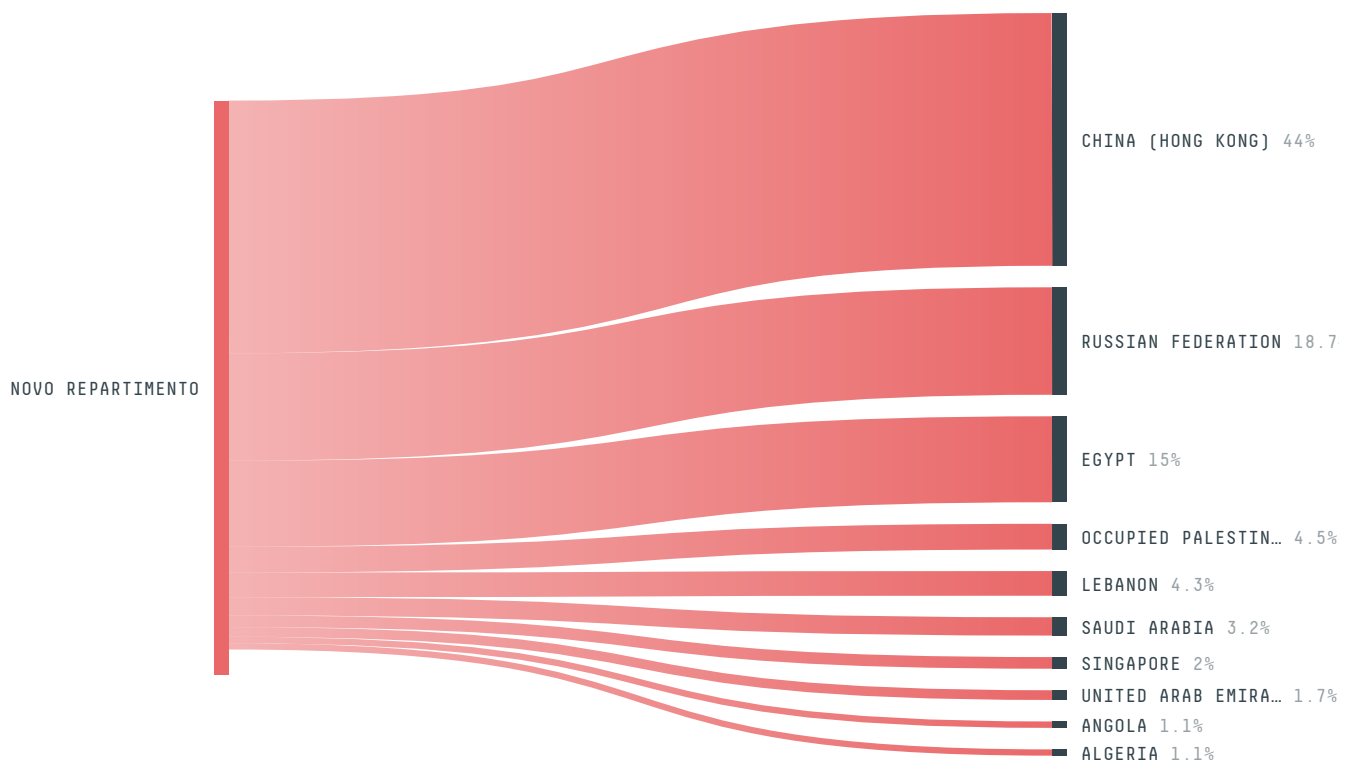
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF NOVO REPARTIMENTO
