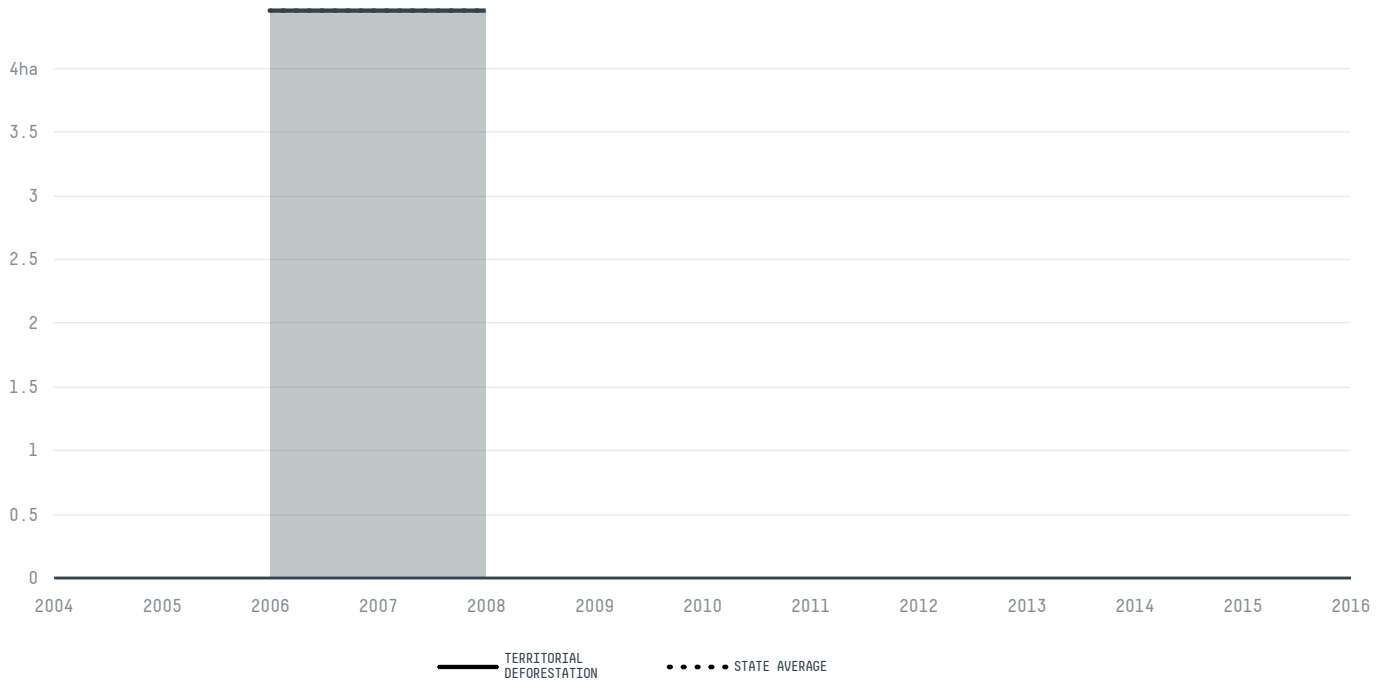
The largest exporter of pork in Amparo was Jbs S/A, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Venezuela.

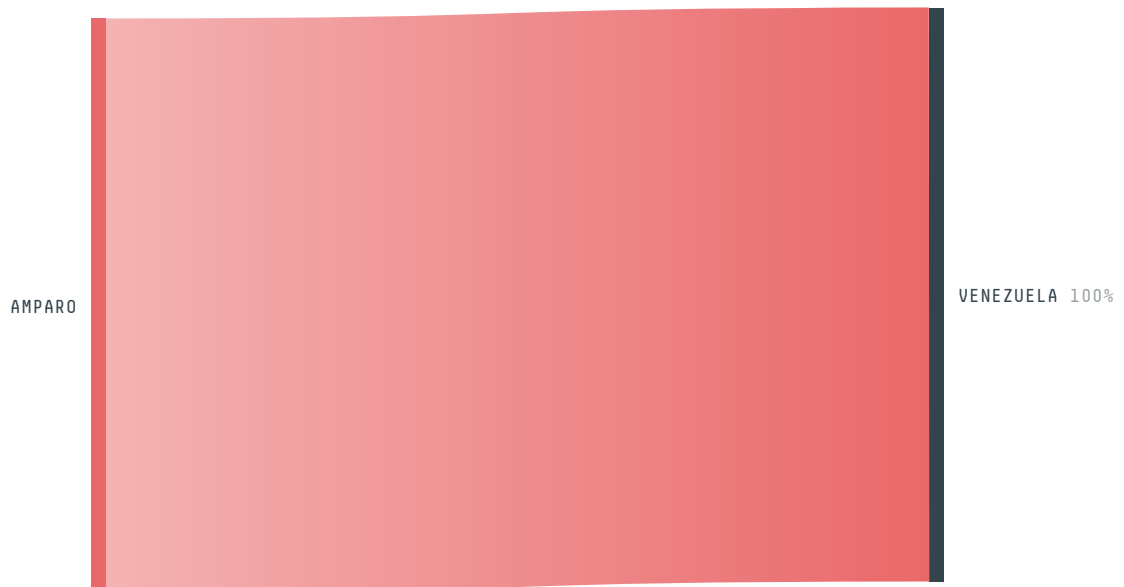

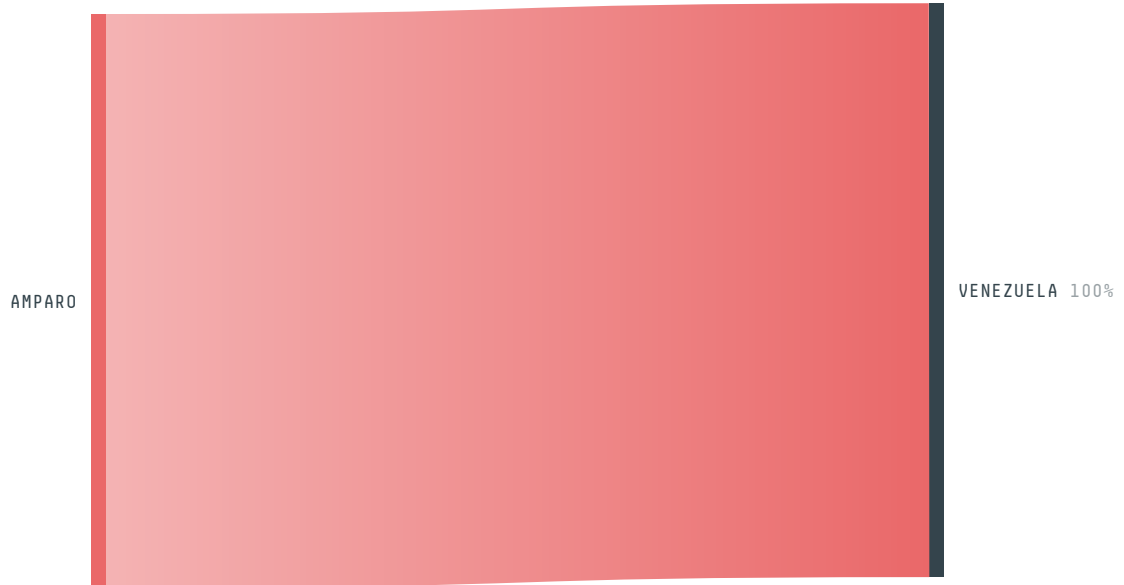
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF AMPARO
