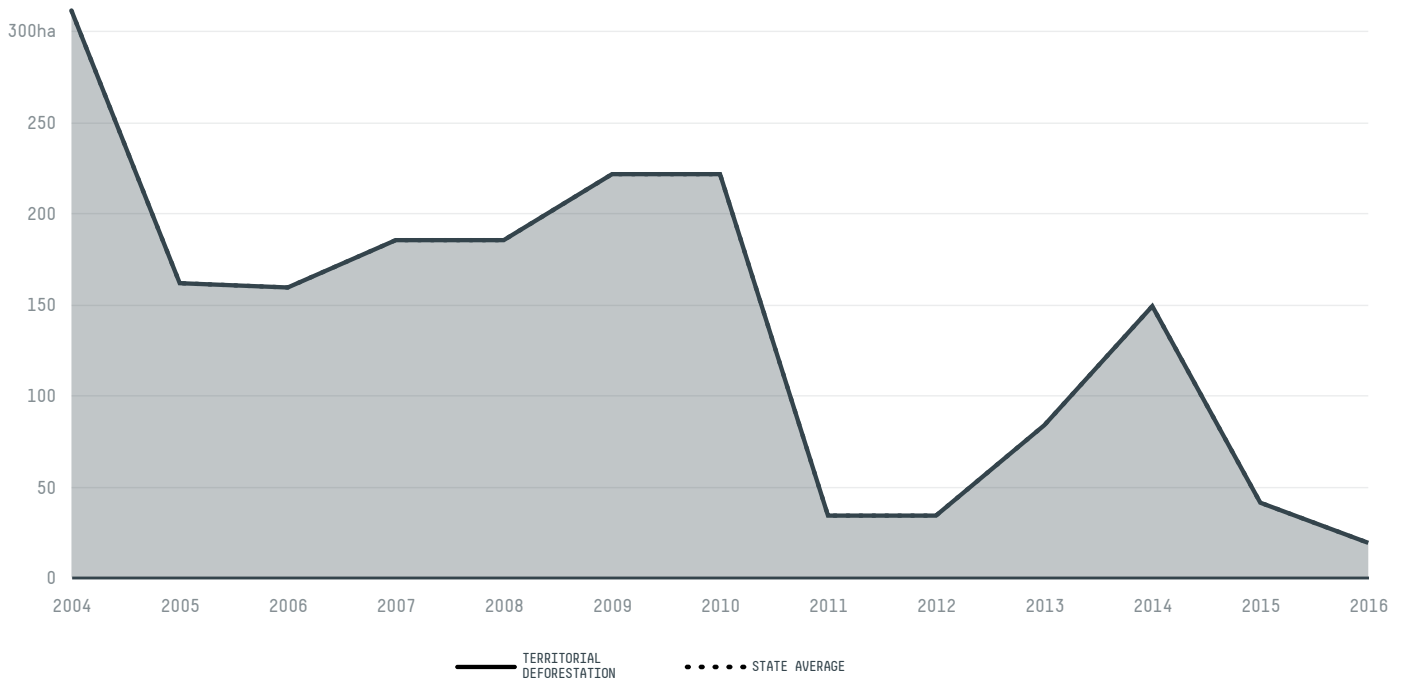
The largest exporter of pork in Angatuba was Brf, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Uruguay.

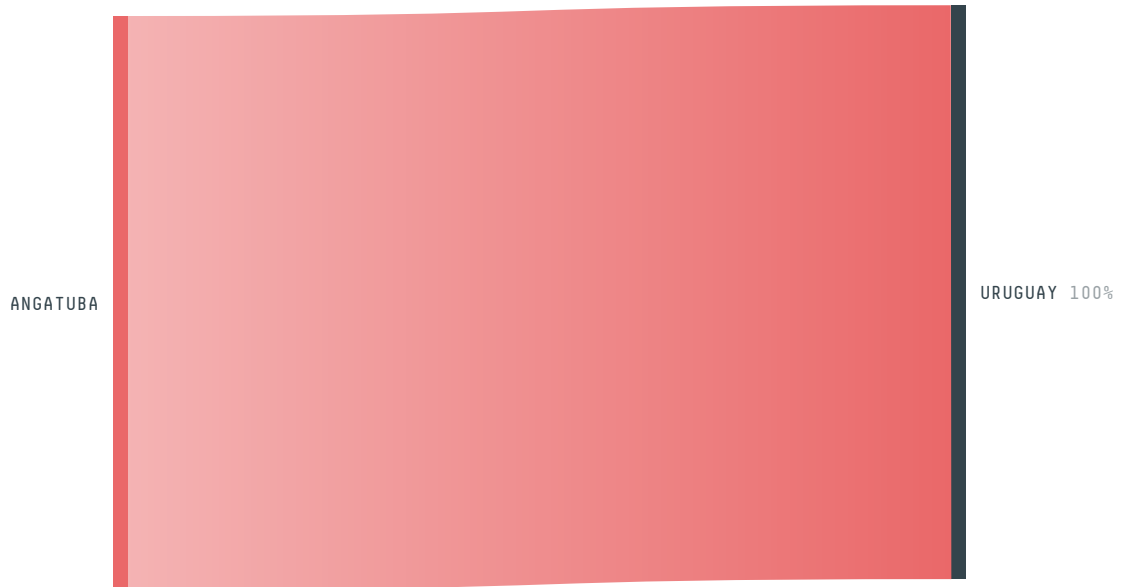
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ANGATUBA
